SUBJECT: Withdrawal of Allied Commission Personnel from Italian Government
Territory

TO: All Concerned

1. Reference is made to letters, this headquarters, file and subject as above, dated 29 March and 30 May 1945, by which notification was given of the officers to be retained by Headquarters Allied Commission in territory at that time handed back to Italian administration.

2. Control of the provinces of Firenze, Pisa (less Pisa commune), Livorno (less Livorno and Colle Salvetti communes) and Pistoia was handed back to Italian administration on 19 June and the majority of Allied Commission officers have accordingly been withdrawn from such territory.

3. Attached at Appendix "A" is a list of the Allied Commission officers who are retained in the territory referred to in paragraph 2 above.

1. About a month or two ago Captain Irvine-Lynch employed two Italian women as Secretary-Executive namely: RUSSO ELVIRA and LA BARBERA ANGELA to assist him in his work at the office in the State Railways Building here in Palermo. As I recall it, he said that these persons were needed to do the work of one very competent Italian woman, paid by the Railways, but called away to Rome by someone in Allied Commission.

2. The question now arises as to what is to be done about these two employees. To prevent disruption of the office, I shall continue temporally to pay them: but the fact that these two women work for Mr. Canniseraci, who himself is not paid by me, makes payment to them seem irregular.

3. Will you be so good as to advise me what action to take in this matter?

SUBJECT: Transportation Officers

TO : Regional Commissioner, Emilia Region

1. Reference your letter XIX/TN/1.4 of 12 July 1945, when the Emilia Region closes down and the territory is handed back to the Italian Government, it is proposed that the following arrangements should be made:

a. Captain Polyblank should be withdrawn and reassigned to another region;

b. The other transportation officers should remain at their present posts until such time as the truck pools can be left to Italian control. It is not anticipated that this should take long, and as soon as all vehicles, etc., are handed over to the Italians all officers would be withdrawn for reassignment elsewhere except Captain Dodds and Lieut. Lester.

c. Captain Dodds and Lieut. Lester would be detailed as transportation officers, Bologna, Captain Dodds becoming the Senior Transportation Officer at that point. The duties of Senior Transportation Officers are set out in the attached memorandum.

2. Your comments on the above arrangements are requested.
