1. The following is the text of a message received from GHQ, C.I.F.: -

"It is obvious that numbers of reinforcement clerks sufficient to maintain even a reasonable standard of efficiency will not be made available ex UK in future. All we therefore would that present holders of WO and NCO clerk appointments cannot be relieved from resources other than their own if allowed to proceed on release or P.T.O.M.

Although existing training facilities will continue to produce clerks of low grade, only in exceptional circumstances can it be expected to find material suitable to assume supervisory appointments. GHQ are reluctantly compelled to accept necessity for immediate D.O.V. action in respect of WO clerks and NCO clerks in key appointments. Nevertheless these WO's and NCO's will only be D.O.V. in cases where replacements are impossible to find and always on an individual basis".

2. Bearing in mind the fact that the provision of re-inforcements for senior clerks in Allied Commission is now almost impossible, you should consider whether or not it is necessary to initiate D.O.V. action in the case of the clerks serving at your H.Q. or in your branch. Applications for D.O.V. action will be submitted to G-1(Dr) this H.Q. on Appendix 'A' to GHQ Release Instructions 1945.

1. On the morning of Saturday 22nd September 1945 urgent arrangements were being made to reinforce the Police strength in Naples in view of the Public Safety position, which had deteriorated following the employment of German P.O.W's at the docks.

2. At 12.40 pm it became known that 150 Carabinieri were available in Rome for transfer to Naples if Allied transport could be arranged.

3. The Police Division of this Sub-Commission telephoned to your Rails Division, and Sergt M.ROTHWELL was spoken to in the absence of officer personnel who were at lunch. He offered to explore the possibility of arranging a special train and at 1 pm confirmed that the matter was being discussed with the Railway authorities.

4. At 1.30 pm Sergt. Rothwell communicated to the Police Division the firm arrangement that sufficient railway trucks were waiting at Rome Termini and would leave for Naples as soon as the Carabinieri could arrive at the Station.

5. The arrangements made at such short notice proved entirely satisfactory, and I desire to place on record my great appreciation of the assistance rendered by Sergeant Rothwell. He received the original

information at a time when he might reasonably have been expected to have left the office for lunch, and the willing manner in which he carried on during his lunch hour reflects great credit on him and his Sub-Commission.


