This is the largest warehouse and transportation company in Colorado, operating two commercial and household goods warehouses in Denver and one warehouse in Pueblo, Colorado.

Operated in 1940 approx 350 trucks - from 1 1/2 ton Pick Up to 12 ton units handling power shovels, boilers, etc. Operated scheduled common carrier truck line covering the entire State. The bulk of the trucks and trailers were stationed in Denver and Pueblo.

Employed in 1929 in Pueblo, Colorado in the general office. Later transferred to the Rate and Traffic Department and remained there for 6 years.
