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2. Due to the absence of a Table of Organization, Enlisted Men assigned to AC Depots are actually doing identical work that carries a much higher rating for men assigned in Q.M., Ordnance, Engineers, etc., sections of the Army.

3. By circumstance the American personnel assigned to the Warehouse Section, Shipment, Port & Warehouse Division are for the most part Quartermaster trained, whereas British personnel are with only a few exceptions General duty troops, rather than RASC. The result is that American personnel hold most of the more important and responsible positions in the various warehouses without the commensurate rank.

4. The nine (9) men listed above are assigned in 99 different locations under 4 different officers at the present time.

5. If the promotions requested are made, the men will still be "under-ranked" for the positions occupied.

6. Favorable action is urgently requested.
