SUBJECT: Reassessment of Status - Mr. E. McDonnell
TO : G-1 (British)

1. Reference your G-1B/7(A) of 23 October 1945, and conversation this day Colonel Buchanan-Major Coulson.
2. It is understood that civilian personnel are likely to be regarded as an increment to the proposed reduced war establishment. In these circumstances, the question of whether Mr. McDonnell is nominated to be held against an SO II post or not would seem to be irrelevant.
3. It is desired to retain his services, and as has already been mentioned in previous correspondence with you, it is considered that his status should be equivalent to that of a field officer.

2. It was definitely understood that Mr. Richard was employed by FEA to be assigned to Transportation Sub-Commission as a Railway Civil Engineer to serve in the Rail Division.
3. In the course of preparation of the papers, the Personnel Division improperly wrote the papers for Mr. Richard as Chief of the Planning Staff.
4. This mistake was called to the attention of Mr. Curtis before I left Washington, and he assured me this error would be corrected inasmuch as Mr. Richard is not qualified for the position of Chief of the Planning Staff, Transportation Sub-Commission.

Mr. Richard will serve as Chief of the Planning Staff, and under the immediate supervision of the Director of the Transportation Sub-Commission he will assist in the determination and supplying of civilian transportation requirements of the liberated portions of Italy.
