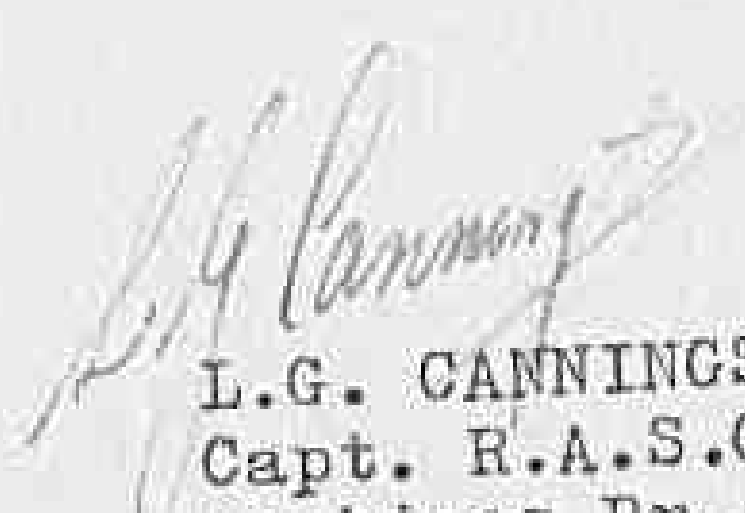

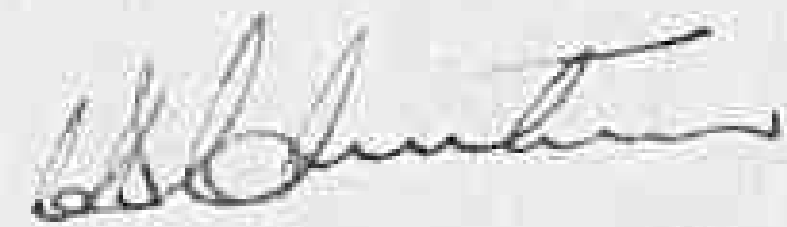

SUBJECT : I. N. T. Vehicles.

TO : Roads Division

1. Enclosed herewith are two important files which should be registered in your Division under a TM 5 reference.

2. You will see that the proposal is made to transfer these I.N.T. vehicles in Sicily to the Italian Government. Please follow-up the question in order to have the transfer made as soon as possible. In view of the black market value of these trucks, it is most important that there should be no loop-hole for irregularities.

3. It is understood that Capt. Calvanese is coming up from Sicily with a list of the vehicles. Please check up on this. When Calvanese produces the list of vehicles, you should prepare the schedule of trucks to be handed over as referred to in Paragraph 6 of the draft letter. ~~Since~~ The draft letter text should be amended to accord with the Legal Sub-Commission's suggestions and the whole should be prepared for signature by the Acting Vice President of the Economic Section.

4. There is also a good suggestion from General Di Raimondo made in his letter of 6 February that the I. S. R. should operate the vehicles. This will have to be cleared with the Minister of Transport; in fact, when the vehicles are passed over to the Italians, it becomes a matter of settlement between Minister Cerabona and General Di Raimondo. At a suitable time I will go along to see Minister Cerabona with you.
