

REPORT ON ACCIDENT

Left the garage 27 August 1945, at 6:50 a.m. to get petrol at the petrol point. From the garage turned to the left on the Via Santa Lucia at point where repair work on road was being done. This repair covered more than half of the road in the center. From a small street on the right the British Navy lorry entered the Via Santa Lucia and drove to the left side of the repair instead of the right. There was not enough room for both cars to pass. Driver of the Nash was obliged to go up on the sidewalk to avoid collision. However, the two cars still did not have room enough to pass each other. When the accident occurred the driver stopped the Nash and got out of the car to see the driver of the British lorry, but the driver of the lorry did not stop. Licence on the lorry not legible. Driver of the Nash got back into the car and proceeded to chase the lorry. By the time he turned the car around the driver of the British lorry had turned into a small side street on the right and driver of the Nash was unable to catch him.

Driver of the Nash returned to the point of the accident and talked to a sailor who had seen the accident and gave his testimony. Italian sailor, Luigi D'Andrea, attached to Italian Navy Mese, Naples, accompanied driver to the Excelsior Hotel where they saw Mr. Uzman and reported on the accident.

1. Captain Irvine-Lynch, until to-day stationed at Palermo in charge of the operation of the State Railway, has been using AC requisitioned vehicle, Lancia I-2. Upon departure he is leaving the vehicle in the hands of Signor CANNISERACI, who has been assisting Captain Lynch, having presumably been put on the State Railway's payroll at AC's direction for the very purpose.

2. The leaving in civilian hands of AC vehicles originally requisitioned for official use is, in the opinion of the Liaison Officer, novel. Captain Lynch's explanation of his action is that Mr. CANNISERACI is, in effect, an AC official and that his duties require travel from the Railways office to the Naval Base and elsewhere.

3. Not wishing to interfere with the work of the office, instructions concerning which have not been furnished me, I have refrained from recalling the vehicle, but am reporting the matter to you. If the business of the railway requires it would seem that the Railway should provide it. At any rate, I do not like AC vehicles running around in the hands of civilians who are not even in our employ.

4. Will you please be so good as to advise me as to the action to be taken? It is suggested that any decision you reach ought be approved by the officer at ALCOM Headquarters in general charge of requisitioned motor transport.



1. Reference this branch G-4/Tn/103/2 of 13th April 1945 and your 107/55/Tn 1 of 26 April 1945 to Economic Section.

2. As you are aware responsibility for all W.D. vehicles is normally vested in Regional Commissioners under Establishment Memorandum No. 34.

3. The above-quoted letter was sent by this branch after discussion with Lieut. Col. Ferryhough in order that there should be some central authority looking after the recording and casualties of vehicles no longer in a Region. It was thought that a similar instruction was being issued from your Sub-Commission on the subject of maintenance.

4. It is very much more convenient for this branch if this can be co-ordinated by Transportation Sub-Commission and this was suggested in the first instance.



Webb at Piombino, as it was not possible at that time to provide a vehicle out of those available in the region.
