SUBJECT: Requisition AC-ORD-94-45.

TO : G-5 (A) - (Attn. Col. Buttersworth).

1. Although no mention has been made in either the justification attached to above requisition or in verbal discussions, there is reported to be some 500 tons of Italian spare parts now in ordnance depots in the Middle East.
2. These spares are desert-captured and/or salvaged equipment of which no known inventory has been taken. A representative from Industry Sub-Commission, Allied Commission is at present in Egypt attempting to obtain inventory. Pending his report, we are submitting AC-ORD-94-45 in its present state, with intention to delate by cable to Combined Chiefs of Staff such items appearing on the requisition as may be found in Middle East stocks. In view of the strong possibility that these stocks may consist of military vehicles parts only (tanks, planes, etc.) and no expectation date can be determined for completion of inventory, it is deemed inadvisable to delay submission of subject requisition.
3. You will be notified of any changes affecting this requisition contemporaneously with our advices to Combined Chiefs of Staff.
