1. Reference is to MGS 511 (PX 90849) of 10 June, repeated to ALCOM, Rome.

2. Advice has been received from War Office that the following supplies on MGS-276-ENG have been shipped on the Fort Rae, KM 223, to Naples.

a. Item 4. 3/32" jointing sheeting asbestos compound, weight 364 lbs.

b. Item 5. 1/8" asbestos cloth wire woven, weight 200 lbs.

3. While the advice from War Office does not specifically state so, it is believed that these items were shipped under Index No. 223/27.

4. The supply position on items 1, 2, 3 of MGS-276-ENG is covered by TROOPERS signal 67864 ESF of 18 August and AFHQ signals PX 37169 and PX 37296, both of 21 August; all signals repeated to ALCOM, Rome, for information.

SUBJECT: Return to U.S. of Electrical Power Generating Equipment,
MGS-216-ENG

TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394
(Attn: Transportation Sub-Commission)

1. War Department, WASHINGTON, now require that the parts of the 6000 K.W. steam plant shipped prior to cancellation of MGS-216-ENG be returned to the United States on a priority lower than military equipment.
2. It is desired, therefore, that Transportation Sub-Commission make the necessary arrangements to return this equipment to the United States as soon as possible.
3. It will move as military cargo and instructions^{are} in P.B.S. Cir. #68 Section XXIX - Cargo Movements SOP and LTOUSA Supply Directive #20 dated 9 March 1945. You will be informed of the markings desired and destination as soon as advice is received from the War Dept.
4. These supplies were called forward from U.S.A. under the markings MITE-ENG-IV-SHP-TOG-U451. For your assistance information abstracted from the manifests of two ships known to have carried supplies against this requisition is attached. This is not necessarily a complete listing and it is desired that a thorough check be made.
5. Mr. Di Ioro, who accompanied the shipment to NAPLES and is at present attached to A.C. (Public Works & Utilities Sub-Commission) may be able to provide additional information.
6. Progress reports are requested.
