TO : Headquarters, Allied Commission, APO 394.
(Attn: Industry Sub-Commission).

Reference your signal 464 of 23 June.

1. The quantities in the AC initial requisition which resulted in Lac Airgram 118 were increased by the amounts in Lac Airgram 114, excepting the two extruders (subsequently cancelled) as will be indicated by an examination of Lac Airgram 118. This was done at the insistence of G-4, Section this headquarters, so that duplicate items would not appear on separate requisitions. It will be noted that the technical data you require was requested in Lac Airgram 118.

2. At no time was it intended to have the items on Lac Airgram 114 flown to Italy. This was disapproved prior to the submission of the requisition.

3. Lac Airgram 118 has as yet not been approved by the CC/S despite continued pressure from this Headquarters. Within the last week we were advised that it was under urgent consideration.

4. It would serve no useful purpose to reinstate Lac Airgram 114 as we are taking every action to expedite the receipt of supplies on Lac Airgram 118, and Ordnance this headquarters confirmed that all necessary items on 114 are now included in 118.

Basis:

1. Items requested on this requisition are supplementary to items requisitioned on MGS-250-ORD/LAC Airgram 93 dated 7 Jan. 45. These items combined with those already on requisition are to be used by the Tivoli Tire Plant operated by the Pirelli Company for the production of tires and tubes in Italy, for a six month period.

2. It had been estimated (para.5, MGS-250-ORD) that upon receipt of items on a/m requisition a production goal of 21,800 tires and the same amount of inner tubes would be reached in the six month period.

BASIC:

1. Items requested on this requisition are supplementary to items requisitioned on MGS-250-ORD/LAC Airgram 93 dated 7 Jan. 45. These items combined with those already on requisition are to be used by the Tivoli Tire Plant operated by the Pirelli Company for the production of tires and tubes in Italy, for a six month period.

2. It had been estimated (para. 5, MGS-250-ORD) that upon receipt of items on a/m requisition a production goal of 21,800 tires and the same amount of inner tubes would be reached in the six month period by using both items on requisition and those on hand as reported in para 7, MGS-250-ORD. However, much loss has been experienced in removing the raw material on hand from hiding places to the plant, hence this requisition. These losses are attributed to the following:

- a. Characteristics in composition and packing of some materials.
- b. The hurried manner in which some of this material was hidden at the time of occupation of the Germans.
- c. Losses resulting from air attacks, etc.
- d. Pilferage.

3. None of the items requisitioned above are available locally with which to replenish our stocks, and unless these items are made available the productive capacity of the Tivoli Plant will fall considerably below previous expectations and requirements.

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4. It is requested that technical instructions be furnished Industry Sub Commission, Allied Commission, as to the processing and curing of American synthetic rubber and associated chemicals upon this and MGS-250-ORD.

5. It is desired that items 1 thru 11 incl. on requisition MGS-298-ORD/LAC Airgram 114 be cancelled. These amounts have been incorporated into this requisition. Items 12 and 13 of MGS-298-ORD. are urgently required.
