JUSTIFICATION:

This request has been screened by this Division, by the Port Liaison Officer at the Port of Pionbino and by representatives of WSA and MMT.

The Romney Huts will be used for warehousing of civilian supplies at the Port of Pionbino. It is estimated that approximately 5,000 tons of grain or wheat can be stored under cover when these huts are made available.

At the present time civilian supplies are subject to the elements, and as a result, damage and pilfering have been somewhat greater than they should be in an area of this type.
