RATING: II.

1. On 1 May 1945 five berths in the Allied Military operated port of Naples reverted to the control of the Italian Government by arrangement with this headquarters.

2. At the time the berths were returned to Italian control basic stevedoring gear and some fire fighting equipment was loaned by the United States Army to ensure proper discharge and protection of cargo.

3. It is now desired to transfer title of this equipment to the Italian Government through the Allied Commission, and authority for the transfer is requested.

4. Following is the list of supplies to be transferred:
