1. Please refer to Requisition No. AC-ENG-1-46 of 7 July which has been assigned Requisition No. HCS-327-ENG.
2. This requirement has been approved, and PHS will be instructed to fill the requirement in so far as possible under "J" priority. For your information a copy of MTOUSA Supply Directive No. 61 of 29 June 1945 is attached explaining the priority assigned. It is not anticipated that your full requirement can be met from this source.
3. Lumber is in extremely short supply and it is requested that you further investigate local Italian sources. Availability Report No. 16, issued by Allied Force Local Resources Section, AFHQ on 13 July 1945 gives several sources of supply which should be included in your investigation.

Laghorn and Genoa.
