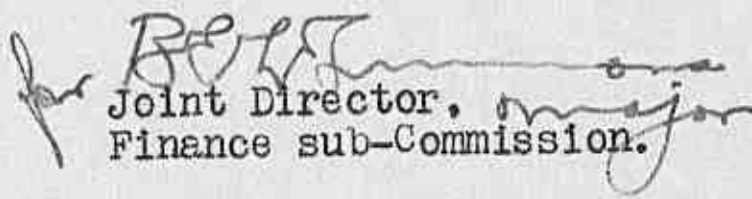

3. It is desired by this Sub-Commission that a Category "B" requisition be initiated in order to obtain the wagon sheets for the Italian State Railways.

4. Will you obtain from the Italian Ministry of Finance a written certification of its desire to use some of its class "B" funds for the above mentioned wagon sheets.

The Italian State Railways have a great need for these wagon sheets, and the Hemp Control Division has advised on several occasions that they cannot sup- ply the material in the weights required. 2. Closed wagons are in critically short supply and losses through pilferage and spoilage of materials carried in open wagons will be materially reduced by acquisition and use of wagon sheets. 3. The following is taken from copy of letter D. M.R.S. Med/Tn 2/ME.83 dated 28 July 1945. a. In January 1945 we placed a demand on the D.Tn., G.H.Q., M.E.F., for 4000 wagon sheets 30 ft x 15 ft for sheeting Railway Wagons containing Military stores. These sheets are now available in Transportation Stores Depot in the Middle East, but as we no longer require them, we have cancelled shipment to Italy. b. Will you please advise us if these Wagon Sheets are required by the I.S.R. and if so arrange with HQ ALCON to place a demand through G-5 (Civil Affairs) Branch, AFHQ. c. Please let us have your reply as early as possible in order that we can advise D.Tn., G.H.Q., M.E.F. that the wagon sheets should be declared surplus to Military requirements.
