Goal requirements ITALY-SIVILY will be considered by ECO with view
 to recommending sources of supply. Important that full information
 concern/requirements, indigenous production/and transportation should be
 available for discussion at ECO meetings held approximately every
 3 weeks 1. SAGHED. Very desirable SAGHED should send representative who
 would act as adviser to UNITED STATES and UNITED ^{Kingdon} members as long
 as military responsibility continues. Please nominate earliest.
 Military representative attached to ECO will reserve FREEDOM to act on
 recommendations of ECO only to extent such recommendations are consistent
 with military policies and necessities. War Office will arrange
 notification meetings and dispatch of necessary papers. Suggest in
 nomination of representative you take into consideration probability of
 limited duration of military responsibility and continued US interest.
