SUBJECT: Movement of Charcoal

TO: Regional Commissioner TOSCANA Region

1. On 10 Jan 1945 Agriculture Sub Commission reported that Agricultural Officer of TOSCANA Region had reported that there was 8,000 tons Charcoal available for shipment and requested that you be informed if the rail line running from PALLONICA to MASSA MARITIMA was in working order and if not that you be informed of any plans to reactivate and possible dates of opening.

2. A report from Rail Division dated 10 April '45 was passed to Agriculture Sub-Commission 12 April '45 informing them that the line had been so badly damaged that the 8,000 tons Charcoal to be moved did not warrant the extensive repair work necessary to restore the line to working order.

3. The matter is now referred to this Branch to consider possibility of assistance by way of Road Transport.

4. Please may the matter be investigated and a full report submitted to this Branch. It is appreciated that the position may have materially changed since the original enquiry in January.

For your guidance the M.F. at the disposition of this HQ is inadequate to cope with existing demands and is fully employed on Priority programmes. Deviation from such programmes would require the authority of AC Priorities Board.
