SUBJECT : Movement of Fish.

1. The following information has been obtained from the Fisheries ~~Sub-Commission~~ Division

2. These are two large lakes near POGGIA in which there is an abundance of fish. On account of restrictions fishing is not possible in NAPLES bay. It is desirable that fish should be transported from POGGIA to ROME and NAPLES. Owing to perishable nature of commodity, road transport is necessary.

3. Previously some permits were given to firms in NAPLES and BARI allowing them to handle this business, including making any necessary arrangements for transport.

4. The amount of fish reaching the open market of ROME and NAPLES was not considered to be sufficient and in consequence a meeting was held in NAPLES at which the following were present:-

At this meeting it was arranged that permits referred to in para 3 above would be withdrawn forthwith and that this business will be handled by the SERVIZI ANNOIARI, who will be held responsible for ensuring that consignment of fish DO reach the open market in their entirety. Arrangements for transportation by road will be made direct between SERVIZI ANNOIARI and ENAC.
