SUBJECT : Movement of Samsa (Olive Husks)

TO : A.C.Priorities Board.

1. Attached is a copy of Food Sub Commission letter Ref. 74-14/65/Food dated 6 Mar 45 requesting the movement by Road of 100,000 Tons Olive husks (Samsa) in April, May and June in accordance with Programme attached.
2. Meetings have been held between ENAC and Consorzio Samsa in connection with movement in Italian Government Territory. ENAC consider that by giving Samsa a priority immediately after Foodstuffs they will be able to move the low Acid content Samsa totalling 34,760 Tons from Regions as follows:-

3. Ref. movement in Sicily (2,200 Tons) and Sardinia (2,160 Ton) This can be handled in total.

4. Ref movement in Liberated Italy (Mainland) outside Italian Government Territory. The 4000 Tons in the Provinces of Perugia and Terni can be accomplished by the use of Truck Pools.

5. The question of Priority now to be decided by you is in connection with the Balance of Tonnes which cannot be moved without disturbing present priorities. The tonnages are as follows :-

Road of 100,000 Tons Olive husks (Sansa) in April, May and June in accordance with Programme attached.

2. Meetings have been held between ENAC and Consorzio Sansa in connection with movement in Italian Government Territory. ENAC consider that by giving Sansa a priority immediately after Foodstuffs they will be able to move the Low Acid content Sansa totalling 34,760 Tons from Regions as follows:-

3. Ref. movement in Sicily (2,200 Tons) and Sardinia (2,160 Ton) This can be handled in total.

4. Ref movement in Liberated Italy (mainland) outside Italian Government Territory. The 4000 Tons in the Provinces of Perugia and Terni can be accomplished by the use of Truck Pools.

5. The question of Priority now to be decided by you is in connection with the Balance of Tonnages which cannot be moved without disturbing present priorities. The tonnages are as follows :-
