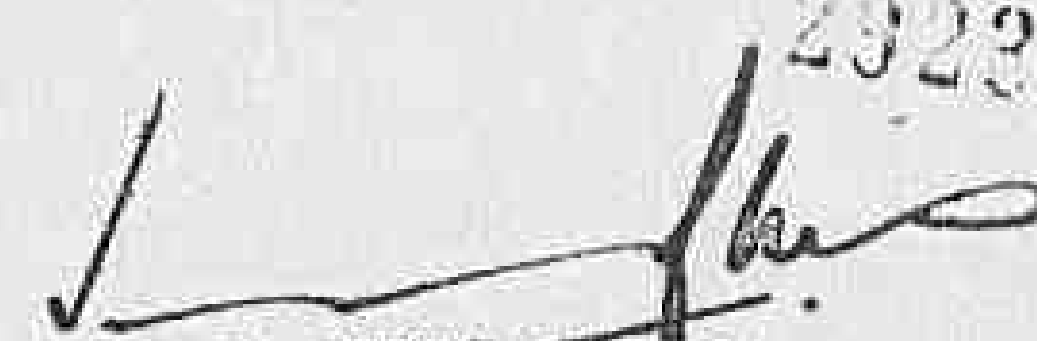

1. A request has been received for the supply of lignite for the Veldent mines. It is suggested that the surplus stocks of lignite at present on hand at the Veldent mines (Veldent) mine would meet requirements.

2. To supply lignite from the Veldent mine, it will be necessary to provide road transport to Florence, a distance of approx 25 miles, as at the moment this mine is not rail served.

3. If it is found that to supply lignite from the Veldent mine is impracticable, an alternative would be to supply from the Veldent mine, loading station Veldent, which is again not rail served, but the distance by road from the mine to Veldent station is only approx 5 miles.

4. The tonnage for movement would be a minimum of 1000, maximum 1000 tons per month.
