TO : Commerce Sub-Commission.

1. Enclosed find application from Societe Italienne Riccerche Industriali whose Head Office is in Rome and Factory at TANITI for 5 Tyres and 5 Tubes.

2. Dr. Luigi Collisano, the General manager has submitted several applications to A.C. to Italian Govt. and to H.Q. U.D.T. during the past 2/3 months. He states that he was informed by A.C. and by Italian Authorities that as the output of the factory was at present being taken for Allied Military needs, then he could not receive tyres from civilian allotment. He duly made application to U.D.T. who having no source of supply, submitted the letter to A.T.B.I. for authority to draw from Military sources. The original of U.D.T. All. HQ (Main) C.R.P. Ref: MAINT/T/44 dated 4 June 45 is enclosed. Note A.T.B.I. instructions that application is to be submitted to A.C. after endorsement by Q.A. 94 O.G.D. (This has been done.)

3. Whilst at the present the factory output is for military needs it is agreed by all concerned that the periodic attendance of Dr. Collisano at the plant factory is necessary. The gentleman concerned cannot carry out his proper function unless he is able to visit the factory and it is essential that he keeps in touch so that when military cease to take output he can be ready to swing over to civilian.

4. Please can the application be considered as a military need ~~at~~ present but a civilian need in the future and consideration be given to supplying from any reserve which may be available and thus put an end to this crossing the duck which has gone on for so long.
