TO : ALLIED FORCES HEADQUARTERS, ROME.

On June the 2nd it will be the anniversary of the death of Giuseppe Garibaldi, whose dead body is buried in the Island of Caprera.

Giuseppe Garibaldi was an English and American honorary citizen, he fought for the liberty of America and France and English volunteers have fought with his Battalions of "Camicie Rosse".

In his name the Italian Nation has arisen against nazis and fascists to fight at the side of the glorious Allied Armies.

The "Garibaldini" would like to honour the Hero and to bring to his grave at Caprera a funeral wreath of laurel of the Gianicolo.

They ask, through me, to this Headquarters to have at their disposal, a maritime or air transportation mean to go to that Island on June the 2nd.

Transportation is required for few persons: maximum six.

I would appreciate very much a reply. Best regards and many thanks.
