3. Reason of heavy cwt's is due to 3150 wagons standing under load in and around Naples Yards all destinations Rome or beyond.
4. All traffic incoming, outgoing, and through Naples Yards and surrounding stations i.e. Fortici, Cancellio, Caserta Casoria is stopped for the above period.
5. Major Blair, Reggio and Capt. Hall Bari have been requested by signal to only load essential traffic over the above period
