In the order to return employees of the Italian State Railways to their former locations and also in transferring employees from one location to another which involves transportation of their families as well as household goods, the following procedure will govern the transportation and movement of such personnel with their effects:

(a) Application will be made to the Director, MRS by the Director General of the I.S.R. or by the Capo Compartimento, direct for approval.

(b) Approval will be either granted or denied to the Capo Compartimento who will arrange for placement of car or transportation for the personnel involved. When shipment is made, a copy of the letter of approval from this headquarters will be delivered to the person being transferred which will be their authority to move through the various yards where RTO personnel check trains.

2. In the past several days such movements have been checked at Rome and the personnel involved have not had proper credentials authorizing their transfer and it is necessary that they be provided with copy of the letter from this headquarters authorizing the move, which will be retained in their possession until destination is reached.

3. When letters authorizing these movements are passed to the Capo Compartimento, sufficient copies will be forwarded for an extra copy to be delivered to the person being transferred.

No.110 M.U., R.A.F. BRINDISI employs a large number of Italian civilian technicians having their homes in ROME.

2. It is desired to give each man a week's leave in ROME and to achieve this by despatching from BRINDISI by rail parties of 30 each fortnight.

3. It is understood that there are daily civilian trains from BRINDISI to NAPLES, and from NAPLES to ROME, on which these personnel can travel subject to the necessary authority. It is therefore requested that facilities be given for the despatch of 30 personnel per fortnight and their return from ROME in one week to commence as soon as possible.

4. Regular days of departure from BRINDISI and from ROME are desired, but the exact days can be fixed to suit traffic conditions or the wishes of Allied Control.

5. A copy of this letter is being sent to AC Railways MOVEIT, who, it is understood, will be concerned with the portion of the journey between BRINDISI and NAPLES and they are requested to provide the necessary facilities.

6. In so far as the timings of the trains are likely to involve a night in NAPLES, your observations on the accommodation of the personnel will be appreciated.

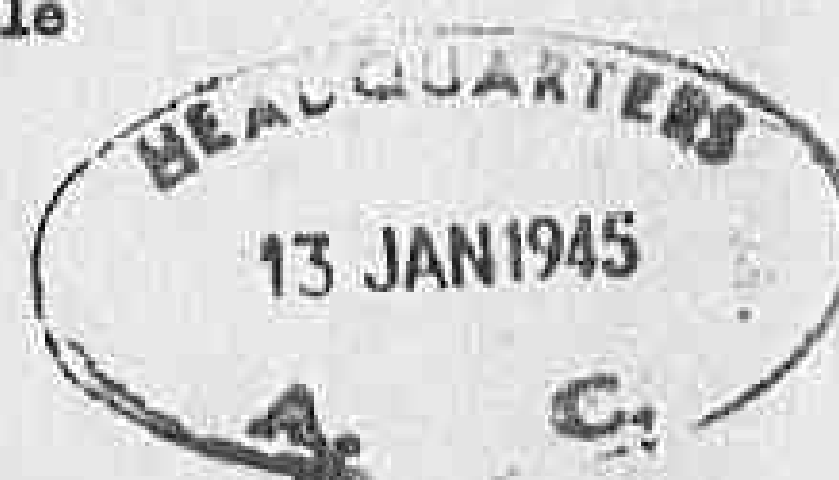

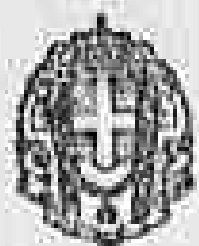

SUBJECT: Trachomateous children.

Both phonograms arrived yesterday must be cancelled. The children are still in Rome and they won't leave for Salerno until ACC's confirmation that the special coach for the journey Salerno - Reggio and Messina - Palermo has been arranged. Therefore it is ACC who must specify the train which shall carry the children from Salerno so that the departure from Rome may be arranged accordingly.

To be kept in mind that it should be as much as possible avoided to keep the children waiting in Salerno, because there are no possibilities to billet them, even for a single night.

As for the guarantee that the special coach be strictly reserved to the children in question and to their escort, I.S.R. is ready to accept ACC's suggestions as to carry out above purpose. Perhaps it would be enough to lock all coach-doors entrusting a I.S.R. employee with the key and making him personally responsible for the observance of above order.

It is believed that the Vatican has a more or less regular service of road vehicles from Rome to Naples and it is possible that, if application is made by you to the right quarter, these Sisters might travel by this means to Naples and onwards by the ordinary civil train.

2. Alternatively it is anticipated that a number of sick children will be travelling by special train to Reggio Calabria in the near future under arrangements made by the Displaced Persons Sub Commission in this Headquarters. If the Sisters can wait for this train, which will probably, run within 2 weeks from this date, their journey would perhaps be more comfortable than by any other route.
