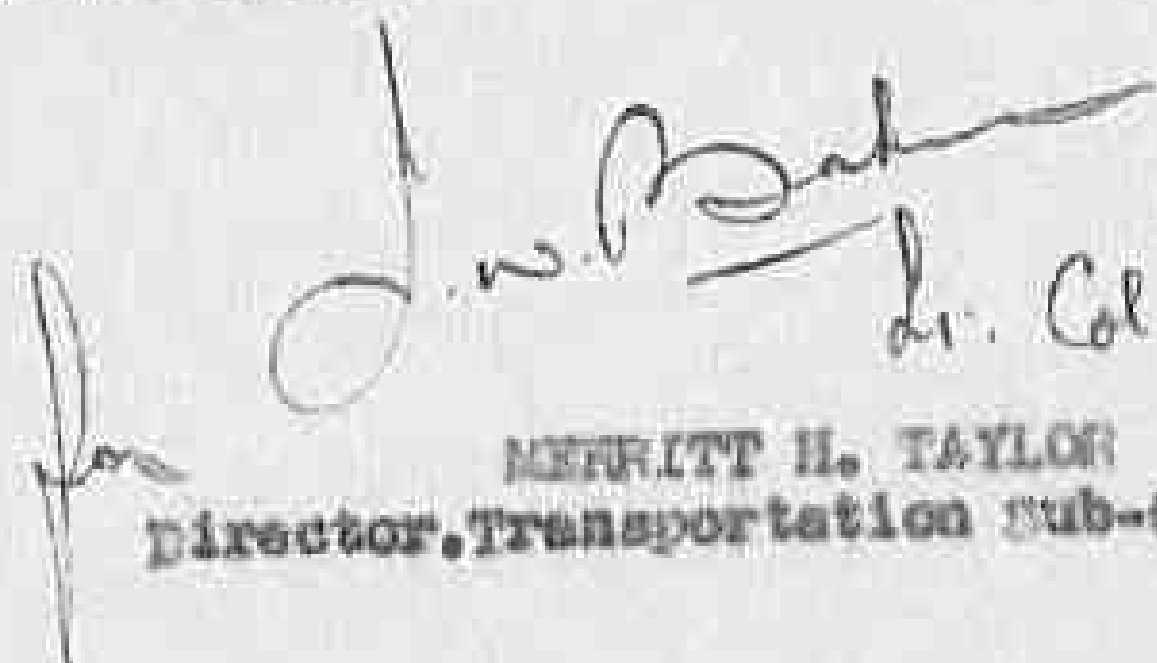

1. In reply to your AG Th/ma 7D /287 of 17 December, I must first inform you that the handling, feeding, and care of refugees is entirely an Italian affair.
2. When I had your original message about the probable arrival in the late evening of the party, I at once notified the Prefect who set the ball rolling. On inquiry I have been informed the train actually arrived in Naples at 0400 hours on the 14th December, instead of about 2300 hours the previous night. The Italian staff tell me the refugees had food with them on the train and on finding that the train was to be divided, one portion for cava and the other for Calabria, and that the train was to wait, they arranged for a meal to be supplied to the second portion containing the distant refugees who left at 1100 on the 14th December.
3. I do not think the Naples Refugee (Italian) side can be altogether blamed but suggest the initial scheme of planning for this train was incomplete and hazy. It should also be remembered their cooking and distribution facilities are not easy plus the added difficulties of a volunteer staff and uncertain train times.

Nothing was forthcoming, although the train remained at Naples from 0900 to 1150 hrs., 14th December 1944.

3. This Sub-Commission has repeatedly advised your office of the necessity of supplying each refugee with the five days' rations to meet all emergencies.

4. Please see that this situation is remedied and advise this Sub-Commission of what action is taken to ensure against a repetition.

Sir,

I beg to report that a special train consisting of 27 box cars with 1000 refugees departed Caserta at approx. 2200 hours for Naples Central. This was a special arrangement in order that they might be fed and receive medical attention.

In order to do this 3 military freight trains were held and delayed. The train arrived on track 14 at 0300 hours 14 Dec. 1944. One Italian doctor and the usual ACC Italian medical staff were in attendance. They stated that food was to be ready by 0330 hours.

At 0430 hours, I was approached by the Italian doctor for medical equipment etc to deal with an urgent case suffering from retention of urine. Both myself and the Italian doctor made frantic efforts to contact the Italian authorities but without result. Finally I asked the staff of 88 Ambulance train which was in the station, for the necessary equipment via a catheter and lubricants. This man was bleeding from penis and had a large swelling in the stomach. He was obviously in pain and if medical attention was not quickly obtained he would probably have died.

Finally as the patient was getting worse, I telephoned the 65 (Br) General Hospital, who sent a military ambulance to convey this refugee to an Italian Hospital at approx. 0700 hours.

The special train departed Naples Central for Calabria at 1100 hours 14 Dec. 1944, without any attempt being made to feed the occupants.

1. The attached correspondence shows a very poorly organized arrangement with regard to feeding facilities for 1,000 refugees, including women and children, ex Rome for points in Southern Italy.
2. I understand that arrangements were made to feed these people at Cava where the train was due at 1500 hours on 13 Dec.
3. The train was, however, delayed at Vairano until 1800 hours, 13 Dec., and I received a frantic call from Movements West Italy that the refugees were clamouring for food at Vairano, and requested that I take the matter up.
4. I spent four hours telephoning to various people, including Cava refugees camp, endeavouring to have food transported to Caserta, but without success. Lt. Col. Simson arranged with the Naples Prefect that they would be fed at Naples if I arranged the move, instead of letting the train go direct from Caserta to Cava. I did this and the train stayed in Naples from 0300 until 1150 hours, 14 Dec., without any food being available.
5. Can decided pressure be brought to bear, please, on the Sub-Commission responsible, to, in future, make complete arrangements for feeding refugees in transit, taking into consideration the possibility of delay to trains caused by unforeseen circumstances.
6. It should not be the duty of this Sub-Commission to make the necessary arrangements for the provision of food.

On 13 Dec, arrangements were made with 701 Ry Gd Div, at your request for a train of 1000 Italian Refugees, moving from Rome to destinations in Southern Italy, to be brought into Naples to be supplied with food. This party, which included women and children, was said to have been without food for 36 hours, having been held up at Vairano by a line block. One hour's halt was requested.

The train arrived at 0300 hours on 14 Dec, but no food was forthcoming. It eventually departed at 1100 hours, without any food having been provided.

It is requested that the matter be taken up with the Refugee Branch, in order that an explanation may be given to 701 Ry Gd Div, as to why the arrangement to provide food and restrict the halt to 1 hour was not adhered to.

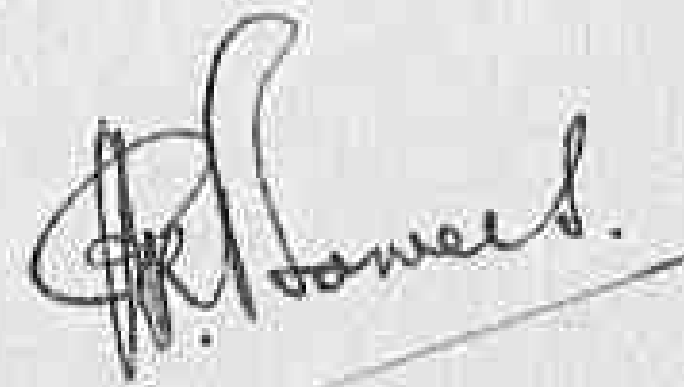

Subject: Refugees.

1. Reference is to memorandum of 28 August submitted to you under this heading.
2. In the first place, it is desirable to make the position clear, as the title "Refugees" is misleading. The Refugee Branch deals with the primary reason for the existence of AMG - the keeping of refugees from under the feet of the advancing armies. They collect them, feed them, and move them south. When they get them there, they refuse all further responsibility in respect of them, and the care of refugees becomes the responsibility of the Region in which they are temporarily domiciled.
3. Unfortunately, AMG and the Italian authorities in the southern areas have been issuing permits, without co-ordination, for a number of these people to move back. They have thronged the railway station at Bari, they have boarded military trains from Reggio, and have ended up at Naples and Reggio and other places causing acute problems of clothing, feeding, and sanitation. As recent as Saturday last, I was informed by Commissioner for Naples City that the returning people were making Naples one vast latrine. There is a messenger service from Bari and from Reggio to Naples, and having secured permits, the traveller has the right to buy a railway ticket, but no one cares whether he will get beyond those points, nor takes the trouble to enquire as to what facilities for feeding exist, nor even whether the applicant's house is still standing.
4. Considerable correspondence has passed through the B C & E Section on this matter. Definite instructions have been issued that such unauthorized movements must be stopped. The trouble thus lies in the southern territories, who are not fulfilling their job.
5. On present arrangements, it is the responsibility of the Regional Commissioner of Region 4 to ensure policing by carabinieri or other guards to stop this unauthorized chambering on trains between Naples and Rome. We have repeatedly offered to take every possible step to arrange for special movements of returning people to their homes if we are approached with an organized plan. But, unfortunately, whilst we have an organization to take care of refugees from the fighting area to a base somewhere in the south, no similar organization exists for the return, and apparently when the people get back to the fighting area and make themselves a nuisance, we can then move them back officially.

SUBJECT :- Refugees.

1. Lt. Col. C.C. Scheuble of the Operating Section of the D.G.M.R.S. appealed to me this afternoon for help regard the movement of Refugees.
2. He stated that every day 160 to 200 Refugees board the freight trains at wayside in both directions stations between Naples and Rome. These people have no permit to travel and no tickets.
3. To guard the 155 miles run D.G.M.R.S. has to place 5 guards on each train which needs 250 men of the Grand Div. B. operating staff to man the trains day & night and they are unable to cope with the situation as it becomes worse daily.
4. Lt. Col. Scheuble appealed to A.C.C. to arrange supply of Guards for these trains or as an alternative to take vigorous steps to deal with these refugees which are menace and he adds that the D.G.M.R.S. cannot possibly be expected to continue to supply guards in such great number without assistance from Military or Civil organisations.
5. Lt. Col. Scheuble offered help in the form of Special Trains to convey organised parties between points indicated rather than have the freight trains flooded thereby have to haul their additional weight on trains being hauled at loco capacity.
6. This is a culmination of a number of similar reports of the last few weeks. Transportation Sub-Commission have no means of controlling this unauthorised movement and would you kindly make representation to the night quarter so that strong action may be taken at once throughout liberated Italy
7. Lt. Col. Scheuble would appreciate being informed of action taken.

2. It is attached for interest as it reveals the obvious impression that exists in ACC circles in the North that train facilities for these people exist from ROME south.
3. It seems a pity that if the women are not really fit to travel that arrangements were not made by ACC to hold such travellers until permission is given for an authorised journey. It is not known how they reached SALERNO.

(c) May ACC be again requested to issue strict instructions to AMG Provincial Officials and to Mayors of towns and villages NOT to issue passes which indicate or might be read to indicate that rail travel is available, unless specific arrangements for this have been made through TN Sub Commission ACC.

SUBJECT: Repatriation of Agriculturists.

TO : R.C.'s Regions I, II and VII.

1. I have been informed by Italian Officials in Rome, that unless the repatriation of Agriculturists - who had been sent South and now wish to return to their homes again - can commence promptly, there may be serious trouble amongst this community in your Regions.

2. I am inclined to discount these statements, because were they true you would no doubt have reported the matter and advised this H.Q. of your views. In view however, of the rumors reaching me, will you please report on the matter by return.

3. This Hq. has every sympathy with the desire to repatriate the civilian population to their own homes as early as possible. This desire however must be subordinated to military interests, and the latter deter for the moment the diverting of any considerable effort towards the general repatriation of the Italian (Displaced) population.

4. It is hoped to get this movement started during the summer. It demands trains, feeding arrangements and transit camps, and the Italians require our assistance. We shall give them this, and help them to get this work started as soon as possible. There is no objection to passing this information on to the Italian authorities if you wish to do so.

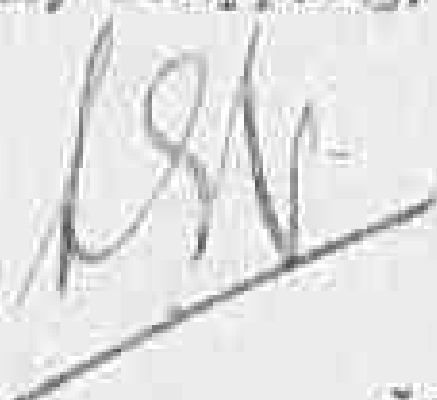

4. (a) Lt.Col. G. Ackerley, A.Q.M.G.(Shipping) thought there was still a possibility that some of these refugees might be embarked from such ports as Bari or Taranto.

(b) Not necessarily by S.N.F. convoys but by steamers calling at those ports.

(c) As and when rail transport is requested (M) Shipping) will be consulted in case a steamer may be available at those ports.

SUBJECT: MT, Region III

TO: The Executive Commissioner, A.C.C.

1. 750 refugees arrived this morning ex Beachheads. We were only able to get 2 trucks to remove them with their baggage from Port. Consequently the majority have been congesting the docks the whole morning.

2. On the 2nd April, the party, also from Beachheads, were sitting on roadside at docks for 8 hours, for the same reason.

3. Port authorities are complaining strongly, on account of congestion and security reasons.

Italian authorities and Red Cross have enquired as to whether this cannot be avoided.

4. I am sure Region III Transportation are doing their utmost, with limited amount of MT available. But demands are greatly in excess of supply. Nevertheless, we should, if at all possible, avoid this happening. It is bad from every point of view.

5. Perhaps, it would be best after all, to give Refugee Branch its own MT for this purpose (as soon as it can be obtained). We could have made full use of during the past 2 months. If there are very slack periods, we could during those times, place a part of it at the disposal of "Transportation Pool"

SUBJECT : Movement of Refugees to Sicily.

TO : The Regional Commissioner, Region I, A.C.C.

1. A meeting was held at A.A.I. HQ's yesterday evening. Representatives of the following were present: -

A.A.I.	Transportation
A.A.I.	"A" Branch
A.C.C.	Italian Refugee Branch.

2. The following decisions were made: -

(1) Transportation between main camps in Italy, and Sicily, will be effected to the maximum extent possible by Rail and Ferry, this being the policy dictated by AFHQ. The object of course, is to save shipping, and although the Rail and Ferry route carries many disadvantages, they are of less importance than the problem of shipping shortages.

(ii) S.S. MARIGOT will take two weekly shipments of 1,000 each, commencing about April 4th, both voyages to Siracusa; thereafter it is most probable that this Ship will be released from this service. I anticipate however that the final decision will depend upon the refugee situation at the time, which cannot of course, be foreseen as much as three weeks ahead. Also the Rail and Ferry service would scarcely take care of the dispersal of Refugees in Western Sicily. It may be however that you will have to take care of even this part of your program by the Ferry service, because as I have mentioned, it is more than probable that the MARIGOT will be withdrawn.

(iii) Thereafter (ie. after 2 weeks) we plan to send you regular numbers by Rail to Reggio, and thence by Ferry. This involves the following: -

- The establishment of a Transit Camp at Reggio, capacity 2,000. It is thought that this is adequate, as it will take care of 3 full train loads.
- You will require a second Transit Camp, either at Messina, or Catania to receive Refugees from the Ferry. The decision as to where this camp will be sited, and your transportation arrangements from Ferry to dispersal will be a matter for you to decide with HQ District I.

3. As notified from time to time the flow of refugees varies according to the nature, and outcome of military operations. We can never gauge ahead what that may be, but we will keep you informed at regular intervals, of the situation from time to time. As an example of what happens, here are some figures:

It may be of course, that a month hence we shall again be swamped by great numbers. Should this happen, the Deputy Chief of Transportation A.A.I., has promised to again obtain shipping facilities at short notice. I understand that there are certain possibilities in this direction with empty returning Liberty Ships.

4. Regarding your suggestion that all instructions, and information, regarding refugees be coordinated through this HQ. This was agreed at yesterday's meeting, except that A.A.I., See Movements Branch, will send the necessary signals regarding ship movements as usual.

5. Returning again to the question of Transit Camp requirements for a regular Rail movement. The Reggio Camp will be dealt with by Administrative Branch A.A.I. giving orders for the provision of necessary materials, and Engineering work. We are making arrangements for staff of this camp. Time is short, but we hope to have it ready in three weeks. On your side, District 1, will no doubt, also have some difficulties, in preparing yet another Transit Camp in time, but with the use of Ferries, it is of course essential.

SUBJECT : Displaced Persons Rail Transport to Lagonegro

1. It is desired with effect 22 Jan 44 to transport refugees to Lagonegro.
2. Such a move will necessitate the party entraining at Naples on the bi-weekly train and changing at Sicignano on to the local train for Lagonegro.
3. For the first move on 22 Jan 44 it is estimated that the party will consist of 150 persons and it will be necessary to have a suitable number of Carabinieri to control the local crowds during this transfer and also to reserved accommodation for the party on the local train.

1. Three hundred refugees should be dispatched by rail to POTENZA from Naples on Saturday 8th Jan., and a further three hundred on Wednesday 12th Jan.
2. A nominal role will accompany the party and notification has been given to Potenza to prepare their onward passage and dispersion.
3. A block warrant will be prepared showing number of tickets required for party. Specimen of such warrant is enclosed herewith. The block warrant will be signed by this section; a previous agreement having been arrived at with the medical and intelligence authorities. The block warrant will then be delivered to your representative. Will you kindly confirm that thereafter your dept. will be responsible for the issue of rail travel tickets to the party. The cost would be debitable to the Italian government and refugees will not be in a position to pay for tickets themselves.
