TO : Distribution Below

1. Enclosed herewith schedules of Sulphur Moves for the period ending 31 May 1945:

1. Sulphur Moves Sicily (local)
2. Sulphur Moves Sicily (export)
3. Sulphur Moves SAIM and DI MARZO Mines

2. With regard to 1. and 2. it must be appreciated that these are subject to an increase of rail transportation, not only to cover this programme but also to cover possible export requirements.

3. Those scheduled show a deficiency of rail movement in Sicily of 1752 tons per month to which must be added that for the transport to port of sulphur for French N. Africa, South of France and the Balkans.

4. Transportation Sub-Commission are considering this problem and it is hoped to refer to this question again very shortly.

5. Additionally pending further details from Sicily, all exports of ground sulphur are shown as from Catania. It is possible that grinding and refining works will be operating at Termini Imerese and Licata in which case shipments can be bid for accordingly.

6. Concerning 3. this programme can be put into operation deliveries being effected according to bids to be lodged, under supervision of Southern Region, on Transportation Southern Region.
