: Rail Section

1. Refer to the recent verbal inquiry of Major McGlure as to whether we could stockpile salt at Bartlett to enable schooners to put in and load without delay.

2. The State Monopoly can stockpile at Barletta under the following conditions:

a. If acceptance can be secured of bids to rail salt Margherita to Berletta. Lorry transportation is not available for the movement. Will Transportation Sub-Commission Rail Section please advise us whether the bids Margherita to Berletta will be accepted. It should be pointed out to Movements that the supply of salt to provinces from Ortona to the front line along the Adriatic depends upon the use of the rail Margherita to Berletta because only the smallest schooners, which can not sail the winter seas, can load at Margherita.

b. If permission can be secured from Port Commandant, Barletta, to stockpile the salt on the Mola di Tramontana. The Mola di Tramontana has been described to us as a private pier of the State Monopoly. Will the P.S. & W. Section of Transportation Sub-Commission please secure such permission.

3. For your information, the agent of the State Monopoly at Barietta who should be contacted by someone certains is Sig. Domenico di Paolo.

1. The attached copy of a report from Supply Officer at Ortona is forwarded for information and necessary action by you.
2. It is certainly true to say that the situation regarding salt supply is always most precarious and that salt in consequence is a favourite black market speculation.
3. The need for immediate increase of transport of salt is particularly pressing in view of the demands we have in every part of the country for salt for meat and cheese preserving and tomato paste manufacture.

1. I have to report that this section is almost completely out of salt due to the fact that scheduled shipments of salt have not been made. On my recent trip to Bari I heard from the head of the Regia Salina at Santa Margherita di Savoia that the same condition prevails all over Italy. The price at Ortona to-day on the black market is 150 lire per kilo. I hear that in the more inaccessible mountain regions the price is 300 lire per kilo. When I called at Santa Margherita there were a good 2000 people there buying sacks of salt which they carry back up to the country on their backs either for their own use or to sell on the black market. By making one such trip a month a contadino can make from 3000 to 5000 lire. Salt is an absolutely essential commodity and there is plenty on hand at Santa Margherita. As a matter of fact there is on hand at the present time 2,000,000 quintals and another 2,000,000 quintals to be harvested and when this new harvest comes off the plant is going to have to close down for lack of space to store the salt. The fact that distribution of this salt has not been made represents in my opinion a scandal.

2. On my trip to Bari I tried to get at the bottom of the matter. I talked with all the interested officials I could find, but none of them could shed much light on the matter. I found that for the month of August 375 rail waggons had been allotted for salt shipment in occupied Italy. But the Regia Salina told me that of this number of waggons only 107 arrived at Santa Margherita. In Bari the officials concerned thought that the waggons had been shipped. The RFO at Barletta said that when he received the allotment he had indented Bari for the waggons but they had not been delivered to him. The ball thus havinf fallen to the ground just lay there for there is no one apparently interesting himself in straightening out the situation.

3. I cannot definitely say what has brought this situation about. It is quite true there is a definite shortage of waggons. But that makes it more amazing is that there is a big movement of wine from Puglia to this region and I think the two are tied close together. There is a big surplus of wine in Puglia and due to the fact that the new harvest is approaching it is being dumped on the market at prices, I hear, as low as four lire per litre. To-day I checked with the RTO at Ortona and he tells me there are four or five waggons of wine daily arriving at Ortona.

4. I feel that I cannot point out too strongly the urgent need for salt. In my opinion the lack of salt will shortly be felt in lowered health of the people. At the moment food such as tomato paste and cheese is being lost and unless sufficient stocks are laid on for the mountain communes within the next 60 days there will be a big loss of meat at hog killing time.

5. With respect to the situation in this particular section we were allotted 400 tons by rail for the month of August and only 100 tons arrived. So far in September no salt has arrived by rail. A small quantity of salt, some 30 tons has arrived here this month by schooner. But the same condition prevails for schooner shipments as rail shipments. The most of the schooners are carrying wine.

6. In my opinion the following things went doing:

a) A.C.C. Headquarters in Rome should be advised of the situation so that immediate steps can be made to remedy it.

b) We should up our bid for rail shipments to Ortona from 400 to 800 tons per month. (I am telephoning Captain Sinclair at Lucera to do this).

c) We should immediately make a bid for 5,000 tons of space on a Liberty ship from Barletta to Ancone to supply that section. Liberty ships can be loaded at Barletta, some such loadings have already been made.

d) Steps should immediately be taken to force all available schooners into the salt haul and stop the issuance wine permits for 20 or 60 days.

SUBJECT: Salt supplies from Margherita di Savoia

Margherita di Savoia salt-works recently found themselves unable to supply with salt a good deal of the Sale.

→ Depots depending upon them- like Vasto, Termoli, Ortona and mare etc- on account of failed allocation of the minimum number of rail-cars which is necessary to carry-out above supplies.

Owing to the suspension of the supplies, many serious troubles aroused; first of all an exceptional affluence of people from nearby communes, where salt was no longer to be bought, toward Margherita.

Even some partial invasions of the salt factory occurred, and several times salt was abusively carried away from the heaps.

In other cases the impossibility to purchase salt favored and increased the sales effected by private citizens, underhand and at "black-market" prices.

All above troubles and abuses will be easily avoided if the Salt- works will be in a position to regularly supply their depots; adequately to the requirements, and this will be possible only if the rail-cars, which are necessary to carry out above supplies, will be allocated to them.

That ACC is therefore requested to take the matter into consideration and to issue instructions so that the efficiency and continuity of this service be secured.

A kind confirmation will oblige.

SUBJECT : June salt requirements

TO : Transportation Sub-Commission

1. You will find enclosed in duplicate June salt requirements received from the Minister of Finance.

2. You will note that salt for industrial requirements is included. The amount for industrial requirements varies from nothing in some provinces to almost 150% of the normal requirements in Naples province.

3. Kindly send a copy of the requirements to your representative in Foggia to enable him to continue to assist in the movement of salt in June. We believe that in placing bids, continuous reference should be had to the storage capacity of the various communes to prevent the consignment of more salt than can be handled. (Copy is in your possession). Where a commune requires more than one car per month we suggest the cars be spread over the month.

4. We believe that the supply points of the various areas are fairly clear. However, we will appreciate it if you will instruct us what areas, judged from a transportation standpoint, should be supplied from Castellamare, Margherita and Lungro. In particular, we are confused as to what points in Potenza province should be supplied from Castellamare and what points from Margherita. Unless this matter is clarified and your representative in Foggia and ourselves informed, there is more danger that certain points will receive duplicate shipments.

TO : Region 7, ACC, Economics & Supply Division

1. We are enclosing a list of communes in Calabria with the amount of salt required for consumption in May and the offloading stations. The requirements were submitted to us by the Minister of Finance.

2. We are not very familiar with the salt situation in Calabria but understand that the provinces of Cosenza and Catanzaro have been getting their salt largely from Lungro whereas Reggio and a few communes on the west coast of Catanzaro have been getting their salt from Sicily.

3. We have told the Minister of Finance that if he would furnish us each month with the salt requirements of the various localities we would do what we could to see that rail or sea transportation was supplied where required. It is possible that many of the communes in Region 7 are receiving sufficient quantities of salt by means of highway transportation. Where rail or schooner transportation is required to supply the needs, kindly submit a transportation bid in the established manner.
