1. Reference your signal 1596 of 27 July subject ACSFA grain.
2. Information requested by you concerning local grain movements has been sent you as soon as obtained from provinces. See. PR/FOOD/45/1 of 24 July.
3. Warehouse stock reports will commence for period ending as of 31 July.
4. Difficult to understand why planning to date has been impossible as you have always been kept informed of PIERMONT grain situation. As is well known, PIERMONT has had no substantial stocks of grain under control at any time during Allied occupation; AOSTA and VERONE have always been dependent on outside sources, and other provinces have been on day to day basis. With regard to ABE flour you have had complete information on movements. With regard to allocations you have had control of movements from RAVENNA and GENOVA, and other allocations have not been substantial enough to affect planning. With regard to mass of grain, information has been promptly forwarded as to inconsequential character during July (PR/FOOD/6/3 of 11 July)
5. As is well known there have no substantial stocks of grain within any PIERMONT province at any time to date for movement to another province. The PIERMONT deficiency provinces have been dependent on outside sources for grain. PIERMONT needs have been promptly made known to you.
6. Fundamental difficulty is crop failure and lack of grain outside PIERMONT to send in, not lack of information concerning PIERMONT situation.

1. About 15,000 tons of old harvest Ravenna wheat remains to be moved into Lombardia and Piemonte to make room for the new harvest and to prevent loss through spoilage.

2. About 120 lorries were sent to Ravenna to load rail cars in the week 9-15 July. It was hoped to move and load 500 tons per day. However, a report was received 12 July that no rail cars had been secured up to 11 July. The lorries were engaged in filling a warehouse at Forlì, one of the loading stations, and it was estimated that the warehouse would be full (2000 tons capacity) by the evening of 12 July. Thereafter, the lorries would have to cease operation unless more warehouses were located, and a search for additional warehouses was being made.

3. In conjunction with Transportation Sub-Commission Rail Section we sent a signal 13 July to AMG 5 Army requesting that 5 Army establish the priority of the movement of the Ravenna wheat relative to Army traffic and allot rail wagons. Because of the transition to phase two it is possible that our signal will produce no results.

4. We wish to point out again the urgency of clearing the Ravenna wheat. It is hoped that you will take the steps necessary to produce the rail cars needed for the movement.

SUBJECT: Clearance of old wheat from Marche.

The Federazione Italiana dei Consorzi Agrari informs us that in the Marche there are still about 400 thousand quintals of old wheat in serious danger of becoming spoilt.

It is therefore necessary to have the above -said quantity of wheat immediately removed for consumption, using for the purpose all the available means of transport.

In order to facilitate transportation, which in spite of all good will continues slowly, it would be necessary to take advantage of steamboats and of the Port of Ancona, the use of which is forbidden by the Allied Authorities, or of motor-sailing boats which have been promised but not granted, and of a greater number of rail-wagons for the transference of the wheat to Puglia.

Your Sub-Commission is therefore requested to kindly take steps with the Transport Sub-Commission, in order that the best facilities may be given to the Federazione Italiana dei Consorzi Agrari and also because the warehouses must be cleared in time for the harvest.

1. We quote below from report dated 12 June from Major Moriarty, grain movements officer for Macerata.

"Attached is 10 day report 1-10 June from which it will be seen that no shipments were made from Porto Civitanova or Potenza Picenza on the 9th or 10th, and nothing from Porto Recanato on the 10th. This was due to the fact that no rail wagons were available.

"Movements Ancona have been contacted but no rail wagons have yet arrived. As a result trucks have had to be cancelled, labour stood off and the whole situation is disastrous, and for me impossible.

"Work at Porto Civitanova was getting into great strides as in the first four days of last week 870 tons had been shipped".

2. Yesterday our office received a verbal report from Major Moriarty, relayed through Capt. Holliday, Ancona, to the effect that the situation had not improved and he remained without cars. Major Curran telephoned Capt. Clinging at once.

3. Your efforts to see that cars are provided for the Marche movement will be greatly appreciated as the movement is urgent. Much grain is spoiling and room must be made for the new harvest with the result that failure to move the grain will result in great loss.

3. I have spoken to Food Sub-Commission regarding the question of increased freight rates and Lt. Col. Imrie states that a certain amount has already been moving by Road and that any adjustment of rate would be a matter for local agreement.
4. Please will you issue the necessary orders to Senior Tn. Officer, Naples and to E.M.A.C., supplying copies to this Branch.

Further to this office letter AC/9/12/Tn.3 dated 14 Mar in connection with FIGULLE Rly Station, it has been ascertained that the warehouses are situated sufficiently close to the station to permit grain to be moved by horse drawn vehicles in nearly every case. At present M.T. is being used to haul the grain to CHIUSI and ORVIETO. The construction of the spur would result in a saving of M.T.

2. It is understood that the quantity of grain to be moved before next harvest is approx. 1000 tons, and, after the harvest, a further 2000 tons is expected.

Subject: Transfer of Wheat from Ficulle Scalo Warehouses.

Our station of Orvieto informs us that it would be opportune to concentrate at Ficulle station, for forwarding to Rome, the amount of grain to be withdrawn, which up to now amounts to about 9,700 and very probably from what was signified verbally to Consorzio Agrario of Orvieto, could be increased to 15,000 Q., by an immediate allocation.

The program could be effected as follows:

1) construction of a railway junction of 10-50 metres to the single rail existing in Ficulle. This work would last three days at the utmost.
2) give instructions to the F.T.S.S. of Orvieto enabling it to forward and withdraw 3 of 4 railcars for daily loading. This request is due to the fact that Ficulle station has no possibility whatsoever of forwarding.

The result would be, a considerable economical advantage, less consumption of fuel, lesser need of trucks and greater working efficiency.

We therefore ask that the request be examined, and instructions given for the working of the above program.

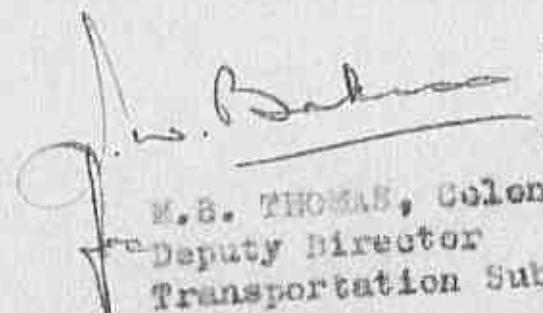

1. Reference your AG/5127/39/Commerce dated 20 March '45.

2. It is not expected there will be any great difficulty in transporting 345 tons wheat seed by rail to Port of shipment, but traffic must be bid in the normal manner.

3. However, Ravenna is not rail served and it will be necessary for this traffic to be transported by road to railhead. This may mean a road haul to Rimini, as 8 Army may not be able to agree to the use of any other forward railhead at the time movement is required.

4. It would greatly facilitate the transportation problem, if the exportable surplus could be made available in an area served by lines which are not so heavily loaded as those in forward areas.
