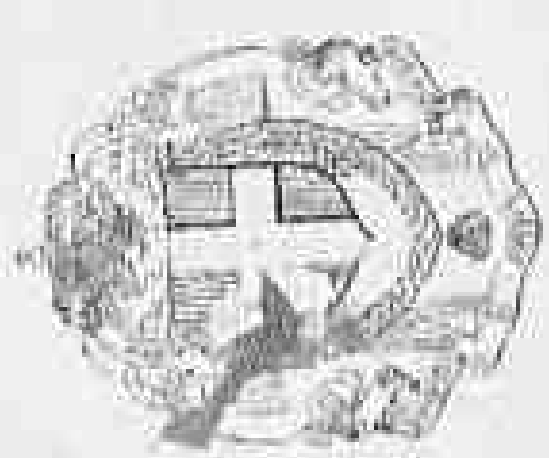

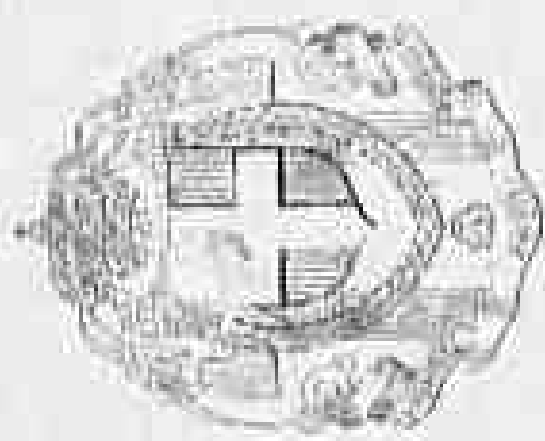
Reference to the letter A/XIII/169 the Ministry has only ordered a total movement of 327 tons of dried salt cod fish from Naples to other provinces.

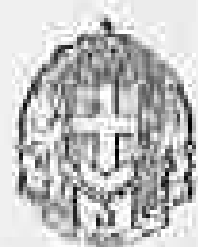

3. A suggestion, and I.C.C. have agreed, was, on every Monday up, stations should submit and then on the day they are received this was resulted in the work week being pulled out more evenly and in plus receiving another consideration.
4. The following facts, of course, that this has movement to arrive. When the S.C. and S.C. are received here 12 days in advance of the delivery something like "movement week" was to, in course too long out, an essential condition, there is no delay.

6256 tons wasted in 7 weeks-all of which could have been put to good use such as carrying fruit and vegetables from Sicily, timber etc. from Reggio.

7. In spite of my repeated requests you have displayed no interest in Forms X B when received here from Stations.
8. Following extract of letter from Natale Scoglio and Son of Reggio Cal. dated 13 June perhaps gives a clue to failures to load:-

" The last wagon we had was allotted to us for loading to Taranto, which car was regularly forwarded - while many others refused to load for that market because of the low conditions in market prices there existing.
