1. An average of 200 calls per week has been received in the past few weeks. The system used to be that these were sent to the C.C. from stations once weekly and then out to the divisions, under supervision of the SAC, and processed here.
2. This service proved too slow. One of the chief reasons for this was that the officer, having made his call at the station, had to wait too long to know if his call was accepted.
3. A suggestion, and I believe, was made, to have a direct line, which would allow the officer to call the SAC directly and have the call processed immediately. This has resulted in the week's call being processed and more quickly and in the processing officer's satisfaction.
4. The number of calls, of course, has not decreased by any means. This has to be done and the system used is now in effect. The only remaining thing is to have the call processed and out to the divisions, which is in effect.




