for June 1945.

POSITION ON 1ST JUNE

At the beginning of the month large numbers of persons of both sexes were concentrating daily at Calabroni Goods Yard, north of Leghorn, and were being transported south as refugees. A total of 1900 per day was usual but the number reached, on occasion, over 2000. At this time no check was possible as no compound or facilities of any description existed.

Arrangements had been made to feed refugees at San Marco Station some two kilometres away but this, which was the best possible solution at the time, caused a constant stream of people in both directions through the switch lines of the main Goods yard and was a serious nuisance to the Railway Operating Company and a menace to the lives of the refugees.

It had been the practice for some time to send refugees south by any train, as and when possible, and although no record could be made or advance information sent the system had the great advantage of clearing transients away from the switch lines every few hours and thus preventing the collection of very large numbers at any one time.

Orders were received early in the month by the Railway Staff that only authorized refugee trains would be used and as the problem of holding numbers reaching at times to 3000 arose. Had the figure of 1500 per day remained constant such arrangements as were made would have been inadequate as on more than one occasion no train was allotted for as long as four days. A steady decline has however taken place the average for the last few days of the month being no more than 300. Factors having influence on this decline will appear later in this report.

ACTION TAKEN

Two urgent measures were necessary.

1. The provision of facilities for the care of refugees.
2. The reduction of the numbers by the sending out of non-refugees.

Toward the solving of the first point the Public Safety Officer, obtained the components of a deserted German shed which was erected, by labour supplied by the partisans, in a vacant area behind the switch yard at Calabroni. By having this shed erected ~~in the~~ in two sections a building suitable for a kitchen was provided and another suitable for an office for two agents of the Quarters who were detailed to be on permanent duty with the object of supervising black market operators.

Five large Italian Red Cross Tents were obtained from Rosignano Refugees Camp and erected to provide some shelter and a barbed wire fence put up in order that the circulating of the refugees among the switch gear and trucks could be brought to an end. Two deep trench latrines were dug and a four hundred gallon water tank made available by the P.S.O., was installed and is replenished daily by an Army Water Truck. Thus some facilities for the care of people in transit have been provided although no pretence is made that a camp has been created.

Regarding the second point. It was apparent that the majority of travellers using this method of getting to the south were not refugees at all. Individuals were questioned by myself and were found to be of many different nationalities.

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1. ITALIAN SOLDIERS. Co-operations P.O.W. Allied Employed and Others; proceeding on or returning from leave, in possession of passes and rations (which they did not use as refugee rations were available and their own could be saved.)
2. UNIDENTIFIED ITALIAN SOLDIERS. Not in possession of passes or rations and appeared to be deserters.
3. SABOTEURS. In varied numbers on one occasion 22 men under an N.C.O., went through on a change of duty station.
4. CLERGY. Priests appeared regularly, a group of 12, passing through on the way to a meeting in Naples. When questioned stated that they knew that this system of free travel and camp facilities were available for all.
5. BLACK MARKETEERS. These were openly carrying large well packed parcels or suit cases, usually six or seven, which they fanned out to other people as they could

not carry them all.

6. BUSINESS AGENTS. Men purporting to be genuine agents carrying goods in a similar manner to group 5, but were in possession of receipts and bills, alleged to be genuine, and merely using a method of avoiding transport charges on wholesale purchases.

7. VEHICLES. A very large group, going south to check up on friends relations and other varied personal matters. Many admitted that they had travelled over this route previously and returned when there business or visit was concluded and that they intended to return in a few days from the journey that they were then making.

Meeting was arranged between the Prefect, the Italian Military Commanding Officer, The Officer Commanding the Carabinieri, the Director of the Questura, the Chief of the Finance Guards, the Public Safety Officer, A.M.G. and myself. As a result of this meeting and subsequent liaison, and Italian Army Officer and a Carabinieri N.C.O., a member of the Finance Guard and a member of the Questura are stationed at Calabroni, each to deal with his particular section as they arrive. Troops are taken away, checked and transported as necessary by the Italian Military. Black Market Operators are arrested by the Questura and Finance Guards and other non-refugees are told that refugee travel and other facilities are for refugees only. It is not claimed that all travellers on trains from Calabroni are genuine refugees, a percentage of the above classes still get through but the measures taken have undoubtedly discouraged many of the seekers after free rides and rations.

Most trains arrive at Leghorn already carrying a large number and so little difference in the type of persons carried would be noticed at the point of arrival. It is my opinion however, bearing in mind that the majority of the large numbers dealt with did not come from any known refugee channel north of Leghorn, that the above checks have become public knowledge and have thus influenced the very great fall in the numbers of transients making their first contact with refugee channels of this point.

ESTIMATED FIGURES.

It was not possible to obtain exact figures until late in the month but from the fact that an empty train, calculated to hold in comparative comfort 1400, would be filled to overflowing and people left unable to find room, figures such as 1500 or 1600 were easy to estimate. Toward the middle of the month this daily figure dropped to an estimated 1000 and in the third week as our check began to operate to six or seven hundred. The last week showed an even greater drop, being an average of three hundred per day except for the 30th, on which day a ship arrived from France carrying 376 restricted persons and made the total for that day 643.

This report would not be complete without an expression of appreciation of the very great practical help and advice given by the Public Safety Officer. Without his ability, local knowledge and connections my difficulties would have been insurmountable.

In the movement of refugees from Florence-Beghorn Area to Reggio it was planned to transport them from the origin point to Battipaglia and there transfer the refugees to box cars in order that the passenger equipment could be turned back and be made available for another southward trip. There was a failure to transfer refugees from passenger equipment to box cars at Battipaglia 16 June and passenger equipment was run through to Reggio. In order to get the maximum use of passenger equipment it is essential that transfer be regularly made at Battipaglia. Please investigate reason for failure on 16 June and take necessary steps to see that there are no transfer failures in the future. CS-543. Signed London. 2957
