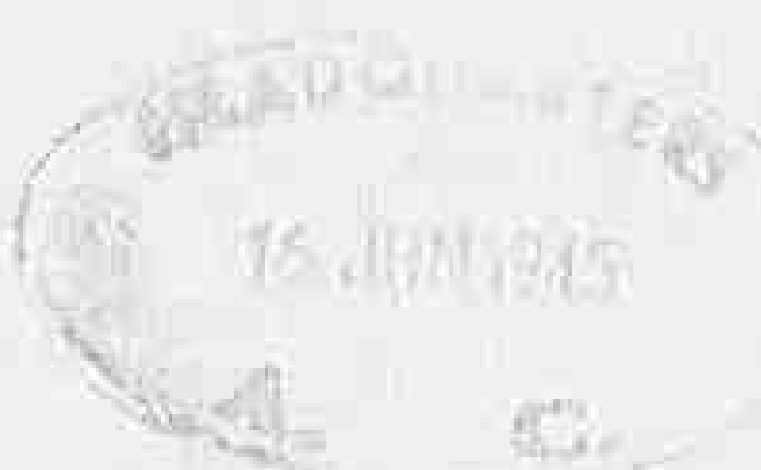

1. Our information at present is that not more than 600 refugees will be available for the a/m move.

2. The office of the High Commissioner for War Refugees, Italian Government has been urged to produce as many refugees as possible at Messina where the camp accommodates about 350. One difficulty in rounding up a large number (1000/1200) is the inaccessibility of the refugees themselves who are dispersed in various houses in the country in Sicily and Calabria, etc., not gathered together in a large, convenient camp near the port.

3. In the circumstances we prefer to postpone future moves from Messina until a more satisfactory arrangement can be made, unless the transportation of a few hundred at a time is acceptable.

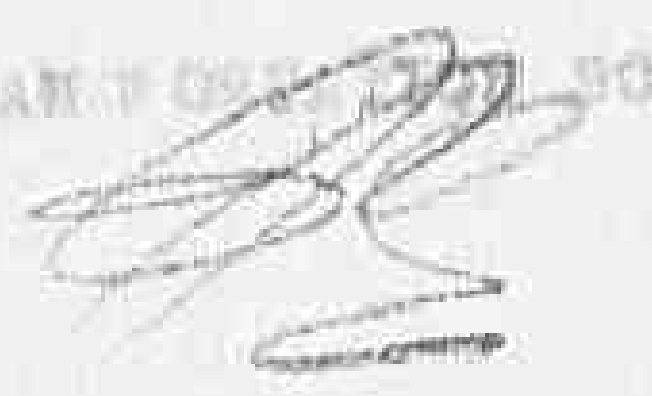

SUBJECT: "Return Home" of Sicilians and Calabrians by sea.

TO: Forward Representative, D.P. & R.S.C.
Florence Rep. D.P. & R.S.C. (2)

1. It is intended to send home Sicilians and Calabrians - and possibly others - by sea from the North of Italy. Sicilians and Calabrians will probably be embarked at LIVORNO or PIACENZA and disembarked at MESSINA.

2. It is hoped to start embarkation on 26 May 1945 and to continue daily till further notice provided necessary craft is made available. For this purpose Florence Representative D.P. & R.S.C. will collect and maintain at one of the FLORENCE Camps a pool of 600 Sicilians and Calabrians. This will be done chiefly by "backloading" from PORTUOFINO and possibly from PORTI and MODENA. It is intended that from this pool 500 will leave daily for the port of embarkation. It is hoped to be able to arrange for parties to leave FLORENCE for the port of embarkation on the same day as they embark, but in any case not more than a day in advance of embarkation.

3. FLORENCE representative D.P. & R.S.C. will detail one of his staff to be in charge of the party who will accompany the party to the port of embarkation and be responsible for the refugees until they embark.

4. 7 days reserve rations will be required on the ship. 2 days rations to be taken by the party embarking. Col. Yoo is sending a Representative to LIVORNO who will arrange details.

5. Transportation sub-Commission, A.C. is arranging transport for FLORENCE to port of embarkation, and for sea transportation to port of destination.

6. High Commissioner for War Refugees is arranging reception of the refugees at MESSINA.

TO :- Navy Sub-Commission

1. Reference conversation of yesterday (Capt. Blackburn - Maj. McClure), it is confirmed that the movement of 2000 refugees for South of Rome from the Rome Area has been carried out by rail, thereby obviating the need for Naval Craft to operate from Civitavecchia for this move. There will however be a number of refugees continually moving into the Rome Area for the South & Sicily from the North, and although the immediate problem of movement by sea from Civitavecchia has been solved, ships will be required for that port from time to time, until regular movement by sea can be arranged from Piombino or further North.

2. It is therefore requested that as many vessels as possible of those referred to in C-in-C Med Signal to FONAM No. 131248B be allocated to supplement the scheme outlined in our Signal No. 2027 dated 19 May.

SUBJECT : Movement of refugees Italy, Sicily

TO : Navy Sub-Commission.

1. We have been advised, that approximately 2000 refugees from the North are now assembled in Rome awaiting transportation to Sicily and Calabria.
2. In view of the present rail transportation difficulties, the question of moving these refugees by sea from Civitavecchia to Messina for onward distribution by rail must be examined.
3. Would you please approach the necessary Authorities concerned, to ascertain whether an Italian cruiser could be allocated for a certain period of time to operate a ferry service for the movement of these refugees.
4. It is further requested that this matter be treated as urgent and an early reply received as to whether Italian naval craft can be provided.
