The following points were agreed subject to confirmation following a meeting to be held at Weisbaden on 12 July.

- (a) Four Ambulance Trains per week through Brenner pass to Bolzano
- (b) Lift per train ~~approx~~ 600
- (c) Road transport from Bolzano to Merano
- (d) Ambulance Trains for this purpose being provided by SHAEF
- (e) 50 Ambulances, plus 30 x 3 Ton trucks for domestic use required for this movement. Major Constable is informing 5th Army (Transportation) of these requirements at the Conference which is being held at Merano on 11 July to discuss the distribution of MT in the North.
- (f) Ambulance train movement is not likely to commence before the end of July
- (g) 6 months medical supplies to equip hospitals at Merano which are likely to hold some 10,000 patients will be supplied from American Medical stocks now held in Florence. The tonnage to be moved will be advised by A.R.C. to this Sub-Commission within the course of the next few days.
