SUBJECT : Transport to and from Tuscany

We call your attention :

- 1) - That the Rome Railway Compartment is providing with rolling material for loading at the stations of Grosseto/Leghorn and Chiusi Baths of Chianciano/Arezzo, which stations are depending in fact from the Compartment of Florence.
- 2) - Following what above mentioned we beg to ask if the Regional Commissioner for Food of Rome, is also entitled to establish on the provinces of Grosseto, Leghorn, Siena and Arezzo, which are depending on these lines, the procedure now in act for the provincial sections of food for Lazio and Abruzzi.

We are awaiting your kind decision on the matter.

SUBJECT : Railroad facilities - TuscanyTO : Industry Sub-Commission

1. Reference your letter AG/5016/RMB dated 15 Feb. '45.
2. At the present moment none of the places mentioned in your letter, with the exception of Leghorn, are rail served.
3. It is anticipated that the lines from Leghorn to Florence via Pistoia and via Napoli will be open by the end of April '45.
4. With regard to the Arezzo-Florence and Chiusi-Florence line via Napoli, serving San Giovanni and Castelnuovo, no date can yet be given as to when these lines will be open for traffic. The re-construction of the Arezzo-Florence line is actively under consideration.
5. Any traffic destined for stations given in your letter should be bid for in the normal manner to either Leghorn, Pisa or Montecatini on the Leghorn-Pisa-Pistoia route to Florence.
