My dear *Johnny*

I think you may be interested to know the form about the
two A.L.C. sidings which are now working.

1. *Admired Mills, Okeana.* This siding has been receiving
about twice its full load, though since it has opened but I have not
made any difficulties about this as they have managed their
discharge extremely well in spite of the fact that the cement under
one of the turntables has not yet set. In my opinion they could
average 500 tons a day with good working and the men in charge
is both cooperative and efficient.

2. *Demetris Agraria, Pevli.* This siding has only just
started work but will I think, be able to handle up to 400 tons per
day. The limiting factor is the very long haul to the siding which
can only be done by a very small Italian engine on the reliability of
which the use of the siding is entirely dependent. Once again your
men are doing their best.

Come up and see us 8.30 and I will kill the fatted calf.

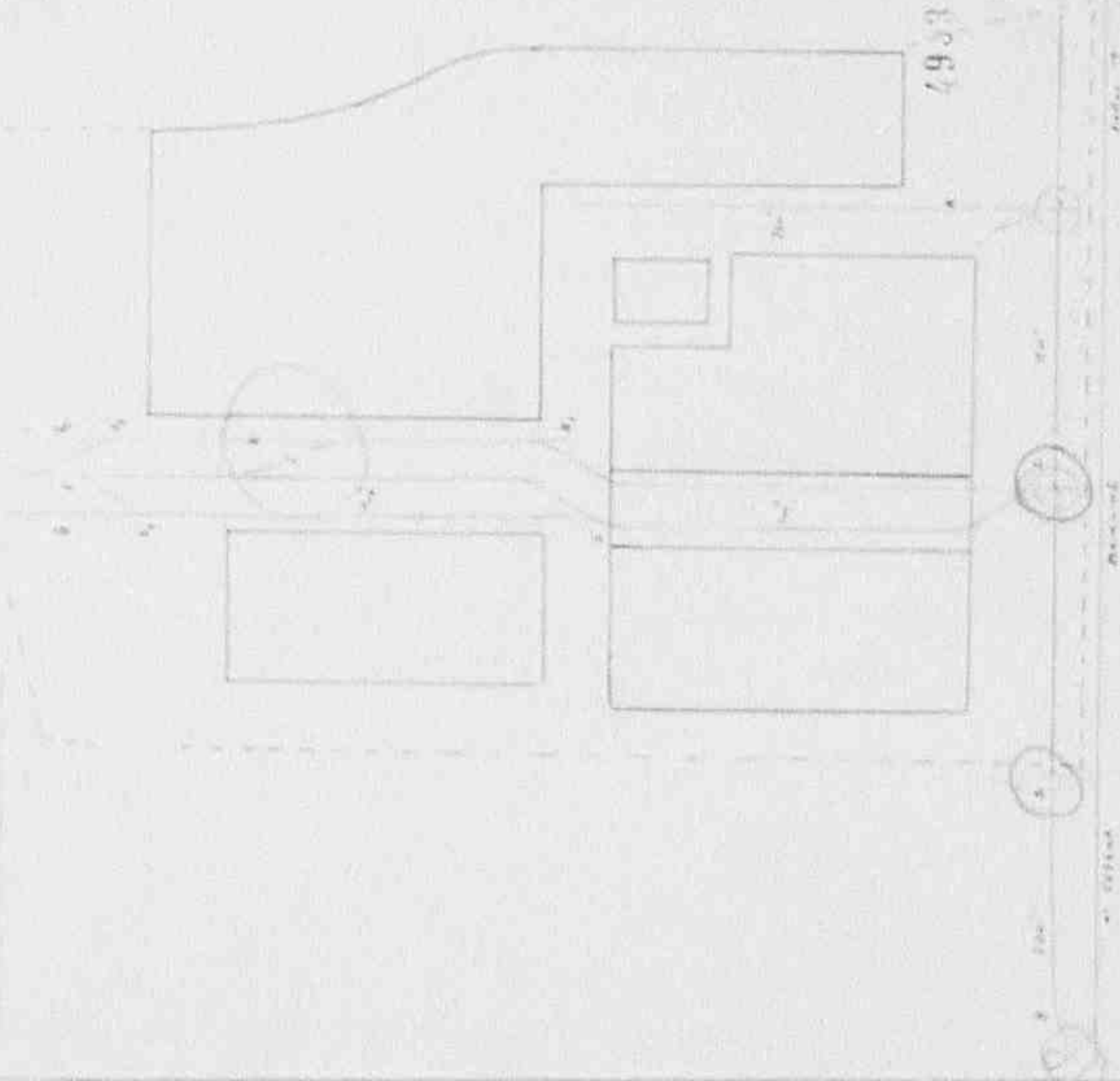

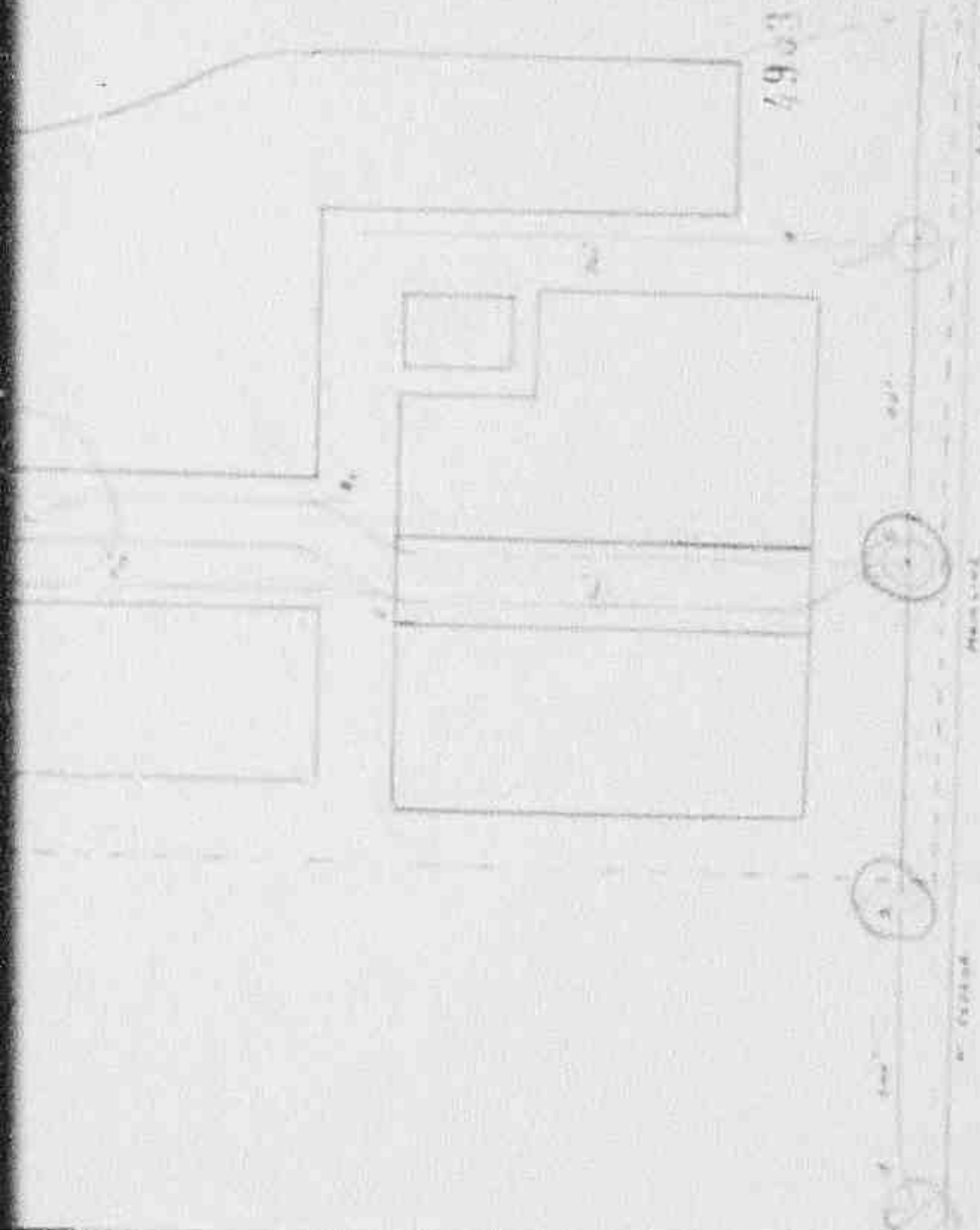

SUBJECT : Warehouses - CEDESA and YORIL

TO : Port & Warehouse Division, Transportation sub-commission.

1. Reference your 2/15/503/70 6 dated 17 March '45.
2. The question of increased rail allotment on line 86, north of Ancon, for the purpose of stocking warehouses, was discussed with representative of C-4 (now 4 70). AFHQ, on 16 March '45.
3. Increase in rail lift cannot be made until movement period commencing 2 April, when it is certain we shall be given a minimum of 500 tons per day. This will quickly clear any outstanding balance for Yoril and will permit a rapid build-up at Cedeasa.
4. No more road transport can be made available.
5. If Cedeasa and Yoril warehouses can handle more than 500 tons per day between them, every effort will be made to obtain the maximum lift required. Please advise tonnage which can (a) be loaded in Ancon and (b) cleared by warehouses at destinations.

1. By signal 16 March 45, FI 44676, AFHQ (THHQB) has requested Rear 8th Army to make available the Arrigonni factory in Cesena to AMG 8th Army for storage of foodstuffs as of the end of March. Estimated capacity Arrigonni factory, 30,000 tons.

2. At the present rate of lift from Ancona to Forlì, Forlì warehouse will NOT be filled prior to 1 April, and perhaps not for some time after that.

3. Since it is desirable to move as much foodstuffs forward from Ancona as quickly as possible, not only for tactical reasons but because Food Sub Commission could use our emptied warehouses for storage of local wheat, can lift. North from Ancona be increased, first to fill Forlì warehouse, and then to stock Cesena?

4. Temporarily AMG 8th Army will acquire the premises in Cesena, but are not in position to staff it. The Warehouse Branch can arrange staffing when it learns when supplies are likely to arrive at Cesena.
