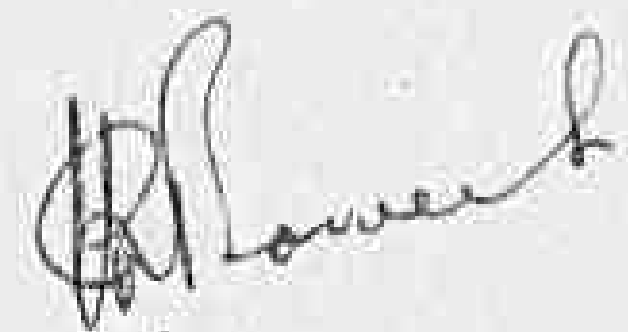

This week they were two or three hours late and this involved almost 24 hrs. delay in printing the programme for Naples Compartimento, as it was Thursday morning before I received it for examination.

- d. number of bids accepted (in part)

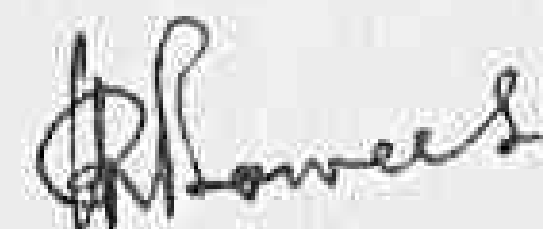
3. This does not however show the complete picture as figures for original bids and tonnages for movement of unrationed foods, wine and empty barrels presented to Sepral are not available to us.

SUBJECT : Movement of civilian traffic by rail.TO : see distribution

1. Reports on operation of Memorandum No.4.
Staff Officers from this Sub-Commission, returning from tours in the areas where movement of civilian freight by rail is governed by Memorandum No.4, report a noticeable difference in the efficiency in operation of the system in the various Compartimenti. In some areas, as a result of energetic co-operation between AC, Transportation Officers and the Italian State Railway, the percentage of traffic moved in each week of operation has steadily risen. In other areas Forms XB are slow in returning and little action appears to have been taken by AC. Transportation Officers to make the new system effective. In these areas there is a little increase in the percentage of traffic lifted, which could have moved after allowance has been made for such factors as availability of rolling stock, etc.

2. Action.
It is essential that the traffic control under Memorandum No. 4 operates in the same way and with equal efficiency, at once, in all Compartimenti, with a view to handing over the whole machinery of bidding and movement of programmed tonnages to the Italian State Railway at an early date. The following arrangements will be put into effect forthwith by all transportation (Rail) Officers if not already in force :-

(a) Forms XB.

- i Forms XB must be numbered in serial so that it can be known easily when returns for a period are complete. The first and last number for each period will be given to this HQ. in the letter covering the first batch of returns sent in.
- ii It is the duty of Transportation Officers to scrutinise Forms XB and to take appropriate and vigorous action in cases of failure to load. Forms should be forwarded to this HQ. as they come in and Transportation Officers will ensure that all returns for each period are collected and forwarded without unnecessary delay.

- (b) Returns to HQ.
Transportation Officer in charge of each Compartimento will be responsible for sending the u/m routine signals :-
- i If any cuts are made by AC, Transportation Officer after

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(b) Returns to HQ.

- i If any cuts are made by AC. Transportation Officer after receiving his allotment of bulk tonnages he will signal HQ. the final tonnage he has allotted on his revised loading programme over each section of line. (This HQ. 363/70/Tm.3. of 22 April refers). Sections of line for which totals are required are those subject to P.O.M.
- ii As soon as forms XB for a period are completed, AC. Transportation Officer will signal this HQ. the total tonnage actually lifted over each section of line, and the grand total for the Compartimento as shown on Forms XB.

iii On receipt of any Forms XB showing failure to lift any important tonnage under the programme issued by this HQ, a signal giving particulars will be sent to this office so that proper action can be taken.

3.

Inclusion of all traffic.

AC. Transportation Officers must check that all traffic in their areas complies with the conditions outlined in Memorandum No. 4, and that all tonnage moved is covered by Forms XB, unless agreement has been given in writing by this HQ, for exclusion of any traffic from this general rule.

(a) For instance olive oil moving from Puglia and Calabria areas in tank cars is not being reported on Forms XB thus creating a gap in the returns prepared in this HQ, for a commodity of first importance.

(b) When authorising movement of emergency bids - such as, cattle from Bastia - care must be taken that an emergency bid number is used so that it can be quoted in railway documents and on the wagon label. Emergency bid numbers should be prefixed with the letters EB and the first letter in the name of the Compti-mento authorising the bid.

(c) Movements Sub-Areas often have an allocated tonnage maximum up to which they can rail stores from Docks Areas without reference to higher authority and in a military port it may happen that AC. Civilian stores are cleared from ships or docks, in excess of any tonnage appearing on HQ, or local loading programmes, by movements against this Docks Clearance allowance. If it is not possible, in such cases, to use Forms XB or AC. wagon labels, the matter should be reported to this HQ, so that some alternative method of control may be exercised and the tonnage accounted for in proper statistical form. In the case of large numbers of wagons leaving Docks with the same commodity it is not necessary to quote individual wagons and weights, but only total number of wagons and total tonnage carried.

(d) Wagons were recently noticed at Assisi bearing old type AC. labels. These carried programmed traffic from an AC. Warehouse. The I.S.R. have shown their willingness to place their employees in any warehouse or docks area so that proper documentation and labelling can be carried out. There is no reason, therefore, why proper arrangements cannot be made at any point to bring all civilian rail traffic within the regulations laid down.

Follow up action.

Officers should appreciate that the proper collation of this information and follow up action is necessary because wagons are still in short supply, and transport will continue to be one of the main limiting factors conditioning the speed with which military redeployment can take place and the necessary Italian economic rehabilitation be carried out.

5. conclusion.

and that all tonnage movement is reported to the HQ for exclusion of any traffic from this general rule.

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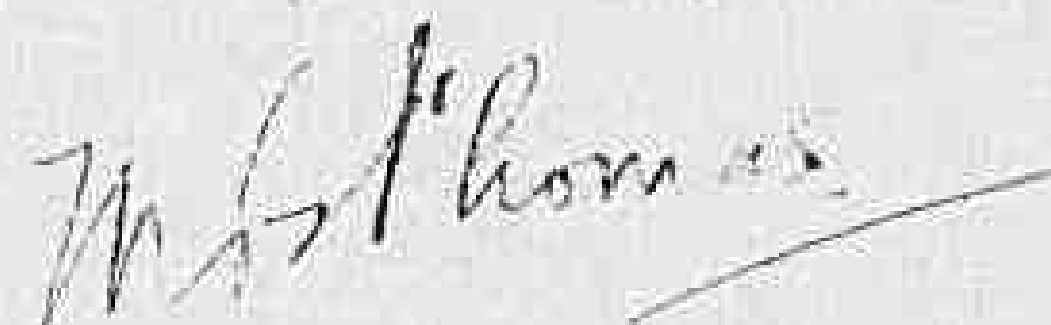
Conclusion.

(a) Transportation Officers will take steps to ensure that the conditions of Memorandum No. 4 are being fulfilled through-out the area under their control and will report to this HQ, before 25th May that the system is working satisfactorily for all traffic in their area or give instances of any traffic not complying, with reasons.

- (b) Transportation Officers, who have not already done so, will advance their plans for handing over the bidding for and control of movement of civilian traffic to the I.S.R., so that they may be ready to make a complete handover at a very early date.

1. Attached is original message from I.S.R. Movement Section, Naples, with translation.
 2. Some confusion appears to be taking place in Rome concerning disposition of forms X.B.
 3. Originally we sent our forms X.B., as soon as received here, to Movements Division. A.C. Subsequently I.S.R. General Direction instructed Naples Movements Section to forward them to General Direction Rome, and this was done.
 4. Then Movements Division A.C. complained that they were not receiving these forms X.B. and ordered them again sent to Movements Division. This we are now doing.
 5. Again the General Direction complains to I.S.R. Movement Section here that they are not receiving them from you, so it appears that there is a lack of co-ordination somewhere.
 6. This office has arranged for one copy of all X.B.'s to be supplied to us, so that enquiries can always be answered intelligently, and we have a complete set of X.B.'s on hand for reference at all times.
 7. If it is required that A.C. be supplied with one copy and that I.S.R. send their Directorate General another copy, may this be clearly explained please to all concerned, because this has so far not been done.

- I. Summary of forms XB for period 6- 12 Aug. shows 52 cars requested and authorized but not supplied due to consignor not confirming loading. These cars were requested through Capi Stazione. An additional 17 were applied for and approved through the Central Office in Rome.
2. Could an explanation, please, be given, why a firm should not confirm that they require a car after having requested it from a Capo Stazione. 4000 cars
3. This information is needed to discover who asks for ten cars when they only need one.
4. Stations where this practice appears to be most prevalent are Follonica, Grosseto and Giunzeo.
5. A request was accepted for two cars to be loaded at S. Romano a station which is not open to civilian traffic. It would appear that the Capo Stazione, who accepted the bid, failed to advise the Consignor, and show on the application, the nearest station to S. Romano where traffic could be accepted. May he be instructed along those lines.

SUBJECT : - Compilation of Forms XB.

9th August 1945

1. A recent review of Forms XB received at this Headquarters, reveals that, generally speaking, there are still too many clerical errors in the preparation of these documents.

2. Clerical errors fall into two categories viz : -

(a) those that may be corrected by deduction and detailed searching of records at this Headquarters

and

(b) those which are manifestly wrong but for which the correct answer can be obtained only by referring back to the station of origin. As this course would involve lengthy correspondence, we are obliged to use our discretion in formulating final Statistics in such cases.

In any event, a considerable amount of time is spent by our staff in straightening out these errors _____ time which should be devoted to other work.

3. The more common difficulties with which we have to contend are : -

- (a) Incorrect Bid numbers being entered against the consignor's name.
- (b) Confusion of rail-cars used for Port Clearance with those used for regular Bids.
- (c) The number of rail-cars actually loaded, is omitted from the form XB.
- (d) Tonnages loaded are often omitted.
- (e) Indecipherable hand-writing.
- (f) Blurred ink on poor-quality paper.

4. There is still quite a percentage of traffic "Unaccounted for", i.e. traffic for which XBs are not received at this Headquarters.

5. Will you please take up these points with Capi Compartment.
