2. Under authy. ATHQ Ref AG.400.312/031.GEG-0 dated 22 Feb '45 the undernoted tyres have been made available for Allied Commission at 35 AOD:-

3. It was intended to arrange movement by road but present excessive road demands preclude immediate movement. Please will you make emergency arrangements to move these tyres as early as possible by rail.
4. The highly pilferable nature of this cargo requires that escorts should travel with each rail wagon.
Commerce Sub-Commission (Lt.Devine) have arranged with Public Safety (Maj. Manifold, Tel.No.2404 ANCONA) ANCONA that 2 guards will be provided for each rail wagon.

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5. Please will Road Division instruct Capt. Bent to keep in touch with Capt. Smith, ANCONA to warn Maj. Manifold when and where trucks are available for loading at 35 AOD and to make necessary arrangements for guards to travel with trucks from 35 AOD to rail loading point and by rail wagons through to 41, Via Assisi, ROME.

It is important that escorts accompany tyres during whole journey from 35 AOD to destination ROME.

6. Capt. Bent will arrange road trucks from 35 AOD to rail loading point unless direct loading to rail can be arranged.

7. Capt. Smith ANCONA will signal this Sub-Commission repeating to Commerce Sub-Commission dept. time and date with wagon No's and arrival station ROME.

Commerce Sub-Commission will arrange road tpt. from arrival station ROME to Warehouse, ROME and for relief of escorts and hand over.

SUBJECT: Tire Distribution

12 May 1945

TO : Commerce Sub-Commission,
Att: Major Wood

1. Reference the Minutes and Appendices issued under
AC/112/16/TN 3, dated 4 May 1945.

2. It is suggested:

a) that a new directive be issued which will not only incorporate a method of requisition and distribution for AMG territory, but also for the method by which tires will be distributed when AMG territory is handed over to Italian Government Territory, and the directive should also cover Italian Government Territory as present constituted.

b) For this purpose, it is suggested that para. 3 of Appendix "A" is incorporated to cover hand-over from AMG Territory to Italian Government Territory.

c) That the scheme as outlined by Commerce Sub-Commission and set down as Appendix "B", be proposed to Italian Government authorities immediately, and some such scheme be instituted.

3. It is suggested that a complete directive should be issued covering all territory, as confusion has existed in the past, but this confusion has not been so serious due to the lack of tires. Now that there is a possibility of tires coming forward, it is felt that all users would welcome a comprehensive directive.

4. It is also suggested that Commerce Sub-Commission take over the issue of permits, authorizing the use of military tires on civilian vehicles. Sample of the form at present used is attached.
