 MRS has instructed the ISR Ry not to use oil burning locos for shunting at this station and there are no coal burning locos used in this area.

The result of this is a very poor service as far as rail is concerned and impedes the off loading of these wagons. There were 66 wagons of grain on hand at I6,00 hrs.on July 27th and only 5 had been unloaded on this maxy day.
