2. The situation at Ceprano in regards ~~of~~ to the off loading of grain is very bad. The shortage of road transport makes it impossible to off load more than 12 wagons per day.
The ENAC people should allot more road transport to this area if there is to be an improvement.
The shunting of wagons at this place is very poor.
MRS has instructed the ISR Ry not to use oil burning locos for shunting at this station and there are no coal burning locos used in this area.
The result of this is a very poor service as far as rail is concerned and impedes the off loading of these wagons.
There were 66 wagons of grain on hand at 16,00 hrs. on July 27th and only 5 had been unloaded on this ~~day~~ day.
