SUBJECT: General information

TO : Chief Movements Division

1. Increased allocation of rolling stock

- (a) With effect from 28 Aug '45, in agreement with APHQ G-4 (Mov & Tn), D.M.R.S. and Rail Division, the daily wagons allotment has been increased from 800 to 1035. This allocation does not include box cars for movement of Refugees, which will be provided in addition.
- (b) In addition to the 1035 wagons allocated for AC and civilian use, D.M.R.S. have agreed with AC Rail Division that still further wagons can be made available, and it has been agreed that, for a limited period commencing forthwith, additional wagons will be provided for movement of AC clothing from 676 Warehouse Naples to Rome, and for wine in barrels from Bari Area to Lombardia and Piedmonte Regions.

2. Refugee Trains

With the allocation of additional rolling stock for AC and civilian use, the following Refugee trains will be set up w.e.f. Monday 27 of August, for movement of Refugees to destinations in Southern Italy :-

- 3 train from Milan
- 7 trains from Verona
- 7 trains from Bologna
- 1 train from Florence.
