SUBJECT : Port Sitreps.

TO : Senior Transportation Officer, AC, Bari.

1. An investigation has proved that Port Sitreps from various Reel ports are often incorrect. It is essential that Sitreps should be accurate and despatched as speedily as possible. A punctual arrival here is most important.
2. There is no need to give recent instances of inaccuracies, but one can be mentioned for a vessel (in this case tonnages discharged were quoted) which was shown as discharging in a Reel port and the vessel on the date in question was discharging in Trieste.
3. It need not be emphasised that, if records of ships are kept up to date, this HQ can follow the programme of ships due to load or discharge in Reel ports.
