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TRANSLATION of letter, dated 14 Feb. 1948, addressed by the ASSOCIATION OF FORWARDING AGENTS, Rome, to Transportation Sub-Commission, Ports & Marine Division, Rome. Copy of Chamber of Commerce.

Subject: Groupage service between Civitavecchia and Corsica and Sicily and vice-versa.

Following on letter sent on 18th. Nov. last addressed to the Transportation Sub-Commission in which we asked the institution of shipping services for the carriage of goods to and from Sicily and Corsica, and in regard to the verbal authorization given by this Sub-Commission for putting into effect groupage by sea through the ports of Civitavecchia - Gela - Cagliari - Palermo - Messina - Catania and Reggio Calabria, this Association began to ask that, in consideration of the regulations controlling exports from one province to another in French Italy, the forwarding agents be authorized in the required formalities, so that they may hasten the coordination both of the bids and the actual shipments.

This Association considers it necessary to be authorized to present lists inclusive of all goods to be shipped each single time and against which they put in a bid.

These lists presented by each associated forwarding agent should include:

The name and address of the exporting firm, quality, quantity, price and net weight, value as per invoice where such already exists, and for commercial goods referring to the value of the goods themselves, and the address of the actual buyer, for each parcel and reference to the export permits for blocked goods.

Such lists, which as said should be presented by each forwarding agent, may thus obtain the necessary visa of the Chamber of Commerce of Rome and be valid for export, so that the AC Region may visa them and the document be attached to the bid for shipment and so obtain the ship for the carriage of the goods.

This Association trusts that the Tn. Sub-Commission will be able to agree to the above so as to facilitate the work of the associated forwarding agents, who are so interested in the carriage of goods by grouping small parcels.
