SUBJECT: Supplies - LIPARI

TO: Regional Headquarters
Sicily

1. Reference your HRS/430/34/B of 25 January. It must be re-emphasized that requests to move commodities must be made by tonnage bids and not by application for specific craft.
2. Every effort will be made by craft control to allocate local schooners, but the final decision must rest with this committee.
3. Craft in your area should be recorded and the details dispatched to this Commission when all possible will be done to retain in local trade.
4. Details required and name, measurements including capacity, h.p. if power craft and name and address of owner.

1. Reference is made to your AC/5/85/In/3 dated 24 Nov 1944.

2. No further news has been received in this Office regarding the whereabouts or state of repairs of 1317 E/Y "Intrepida" allocated to Lipari.

3. It is hoped that immediate steps may be taken to get this schooner at work as the position of Lipari is at present very difficult.

4. With reference to your AC/5/72/3 dated 17 Nov 1944, this Office would be glad to know whether or not the question of the re-allocation of the E/Y Lorenzo to Lipari has been carried farther. The latter from G-4, A.F.H.L. (Mov & Tr) 5/13/GEM dated 12 Nov 44, of which you sent us a copy, appeared to hold out hopes that this could be arranged.
