SUBJECT : Clearance of Cargoes from Port.

TO : AMS Liguria Region for PLO Genoa.

1. The clearance by rail and other means is watched daily. From the information available here it would appear that rail and road clearance usually fall short of total tonnages discharged in the port.

2. It is therefore logical to assume the balance of cargoes are held in warehouses pending further wagons becoming available. Some cargoes are also distributed locally, but if a backlog occurs over a period warehouses are liable to become overtaxed.

3. It is requested that you indicate by a signal or weekly report what the estimated tonnages of cargoes are which remain in the port ready for onward despatch. Swiss cargoes should be included as the maximum rail clearance from the port must include all cargoes the majority of which are moving northwards.

The limiting factor at this port at present is rail clearance. At a meeting held between rail and port authorities, the rail authorities declared that they could clear only 100 wagons (approx. 5000 tons) per day from port railheads. After a great deal of discussion they offered to clear an additional 100 cars per day if the cargo were road hauled to inland rail heads. Rail authorities have promised an additional clearance from port of 100 cars per day by 30 September and 100 by 31 October. The opinion of the port authorities, in which I concur, is that with aggressive use of present facilities they could clear 8000 tons from port area now. I would suggest that operations expert be sent to survey conditions and recommend improvements.
