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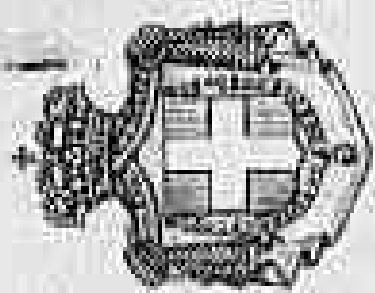

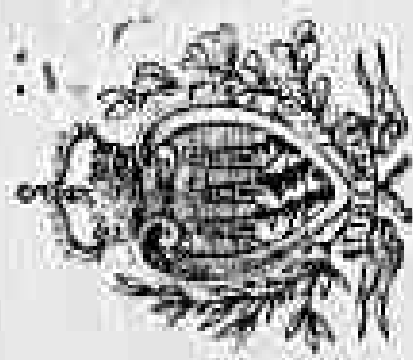

A Captain of the Yugoslavia army, Liaison officer here in Naples, came to my office with the following story:

Two Yugoslav former prisoners of war, to keep from starving to death, organized a little export business in Sicily. They have followed all of the necessary procedure but because they are not Italians, they think, they have been discriminated against. They have never received a space allocation.

They are: JACIO MEDINA & LION MEDINA. Their cargoes are at Palermo, Trapani, Mazzara and Marsala - consigned to Rome under Chamber of Commerce permit 213/102, dated 8/8/44 for 80 tons Salt fish, fish in oil & wine.

I told them I'd write to you to see if there is any help you can, and want to give them.

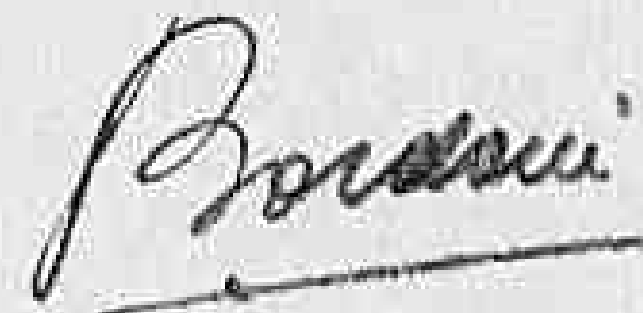

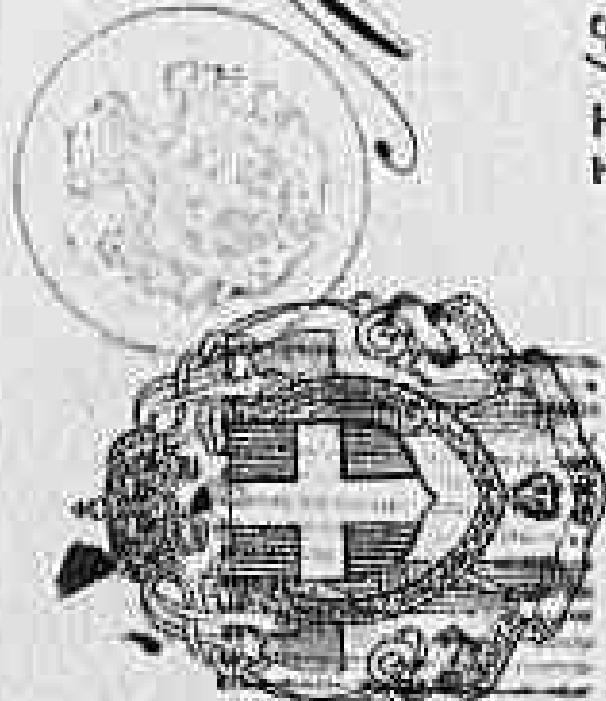

Being an honest citizen, I call your attention on the abuses of authority done by employees of the Sepral of Rome in the allocation of schooners to ship wine. During many months I did not succeed in having the allocation either of wagons, or trucks or schooners to transport food supplies which are more useful to the Capital. Several times I submitted applications to transport fruits, chestnuts, almonds, potatoes etc. to the Sepral, to which I proposed convenient prices, but I have not reply.

At the same time, steamers and schooners were sent to Gallipoli to help the wine traders, who surely are sharing their gains with the employees of the Sepral of Rome.

The Allied Command has always forbidden the transport of wine, admitting priority to other stuffs, more important, but there are still persons who are interested in gaining and therefore they are paralyzing the honest work of the Roman people.

The Seprla organization is a real camorrism and I want to demonstrate you with this example.

"Wine is costing at Lecce only 16,25 liras per liter with a surplus of 8 liras for general expenses. The transport of wine from Campi Salentino to Gallipoli by rail and from here to Anzio or Civitavecchia by schooners and from here to Rome by trucks, including the insurance as for war risks, will give us a total cost of 24,28 liras per liter. But it happens that the Sepral has concluded a contract with a certain Pace Vito to despatch wine from Campi Salentino on the basis of 43 liras per liter. 750 quintals of this wine have already been despatched during these days from Gallipoli. Therefore there will be a benefit of 16,250.000 liras which subtracted from the sum of 9093.750 liras for general expenses, will give a net gain of 7.000.000 of liras.

If we there consider that the wine has a graduation of 15 degrees and that the Firm must deliver to the Sepral wine of 12½-13 degrees, it is easy to understand that wine will be watered and sold on the market of Rome at 55,60 liras per liter giving in a month a benefit of more than 10.000.000 liras

Being anymore under fascist regime where single persons were favoured, as an honest proletary I ask you to consider the problem and stop all these abuses which are dishonouring more our poor Italy.

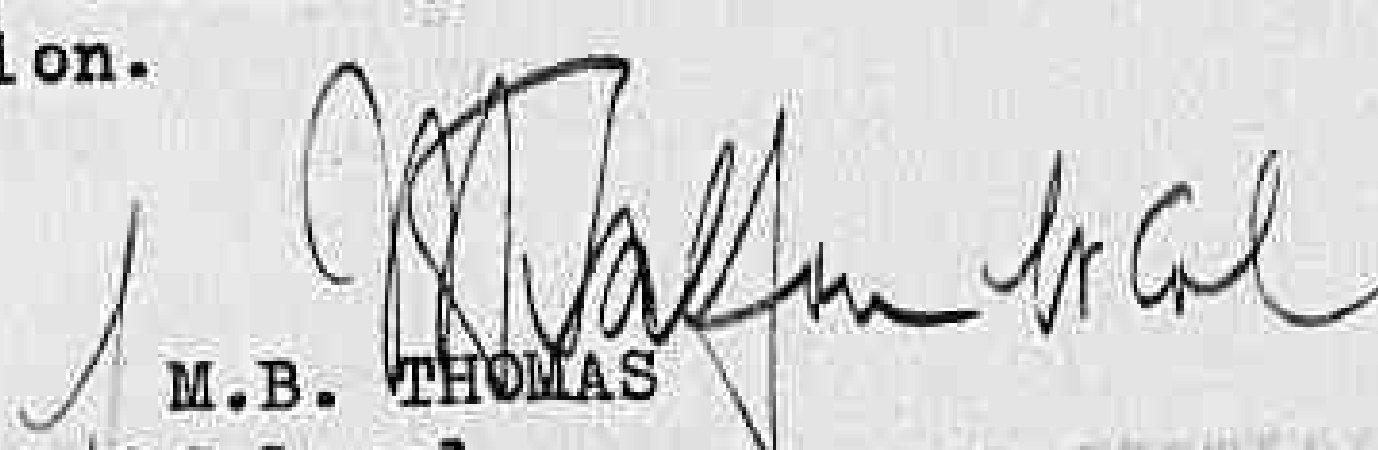

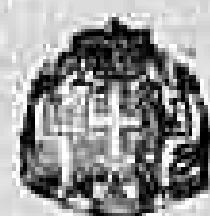

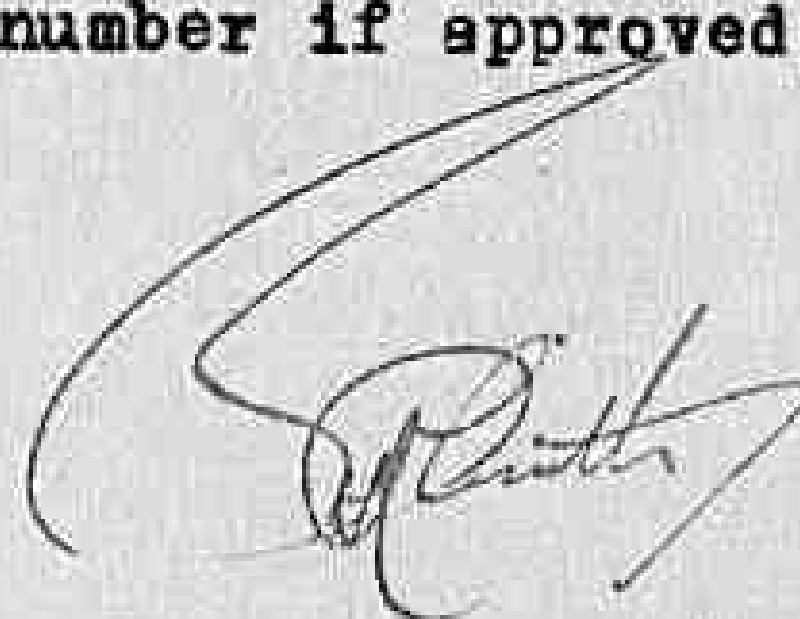

We hope that you will consider the matter and that you will recommend to accept our applications."

With a letter ref. N° 2782/33, dated January the 18th, the COGENA replied that it was not up to it to order the allocation, which ought to be submitted to the Headquarters Allied Commission Transportation Sub-Commission of Rome, thru the local ^{4,922} the place where commodities are shipped. As this Comune has the intention to organize the export of citrus fruits and of fruits from Sicily and even from Calabria to help the serious food situation of the population, we think that our plan has a peculiar character of public interest.

Therefore this Administration hopes that those Offices will accept this application in authorizing the requested allocation with a certain urgency in order that the population might be helped especially in these winter months which are the most critical of the year.

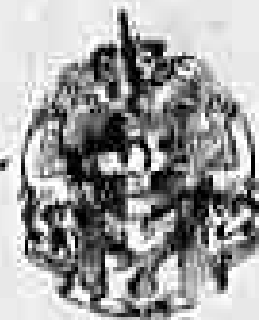

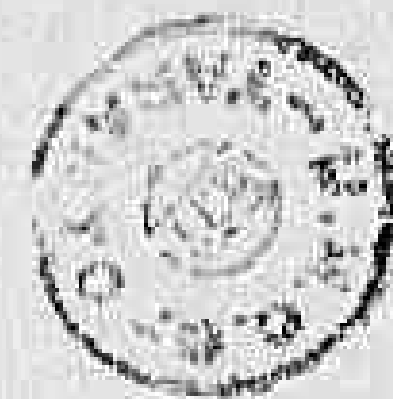
