SUBJECT :- Delays to ships in Genoa & Savona.

TO :- Chief
Movements Div.

1. During this month there have been delays to ships in the ports of Genoa and Savona. One of the reasons advanced for delays to ships has been the lack of sufficient railway wagons for clearance of cargoes, the majority of which is destined for towns in the industrial regions in the north.
2. The Swiss Federal Authorities are being pressed to ensure a steady flow of railway wagons in Genoa area and, if possible, to ensure a pool of wagons against unexpected or sudden arrivals of ships. This will, however, not benefit clearance of Italian cargoes, but will assist in speedier turn-round of ships.
3. Please examine the present position and what the possibilities of clearance are for the future. Recently, the clearances by rail from the port of Genoa have been good (Swiss & Austrian Cargoes included), but it tends to be erratic and this immediately affects the rate of discharge of ships in port. The previous difficulties of movement of wagons in the port, have now been overcome, but the problem now appears to be one of availability of wagons.
4. The large number of Colliers expected in future months will necessitate ample wagon clearance for coal as well as raw materials and food which are due shortly. Further, 2 new liberty berths (Nos 7&8*) are expected to be ready to accept ships on 18 November. These berths should be fast working ones, having good road access and are also railed served.

1. Examination of sitreps for the ports of Genoa and Savona since commencement of month of November shows that there have been numerous delays to ships which have been in port waiting to discharge in some instances for several days.

2. It is realised that exceptionally heavy rains have prevented ships working (this happened especially during the first few days of November), but with the prospects of particularly heavy coal shipments into these 2 ports during December it is important that the port should be worked to its maximum capacity and that there should be no backlog of ships waiting to work.

3. It is requested that the maximum capacity of these ports should be examined in case the ports are being overburdened. This matter could then be raised at the next meeting of Import Programming and Port Reception Committee when tonnage allocations are decided for Genoa and Savona.

4. It is requested that the delays to ships in these ports be examined and reasons obtained for the present hold up, so that any difficulties can be considered. Every effort is being made to obtain the maximum clearance by rail, and the Swiss Federal Authorities are also being pressed to ensure a steady flow of empty wagons in the port of Genoa.

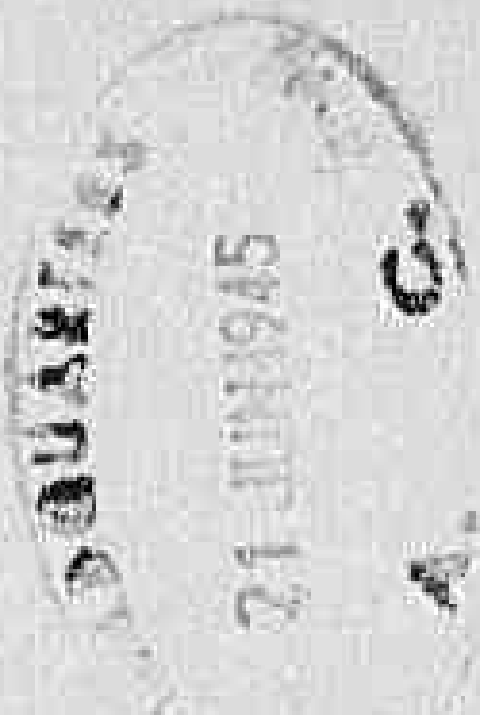

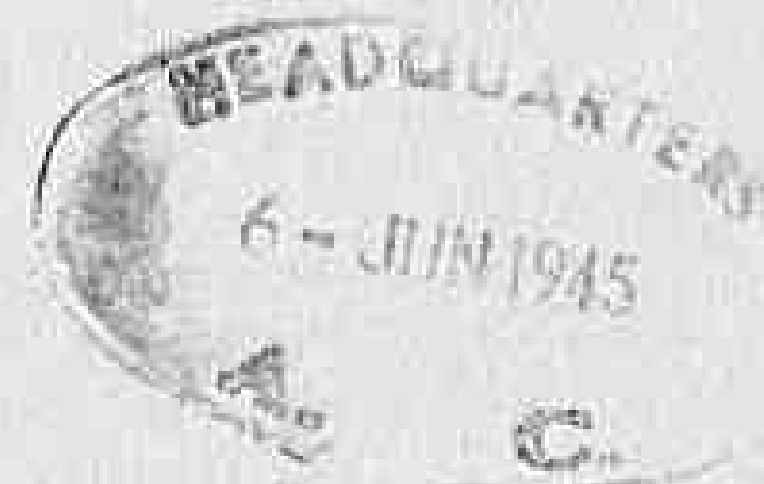
