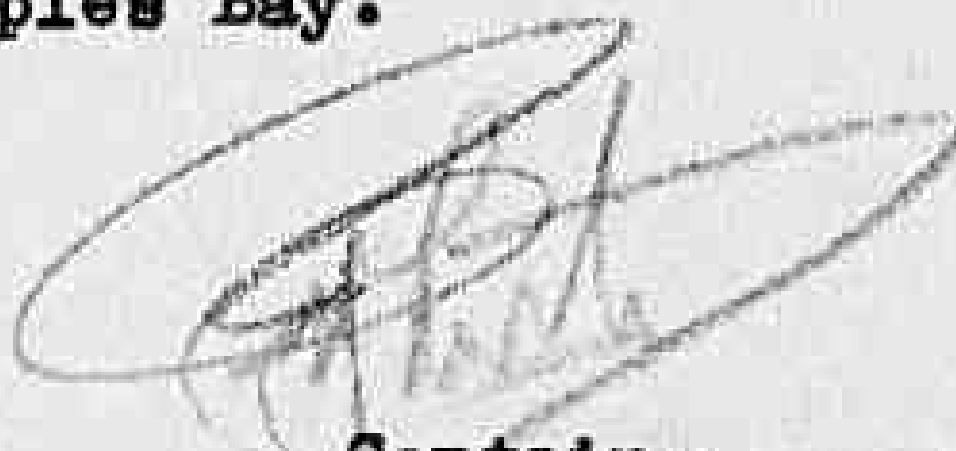

A request to load ammunition had been refused, because civil cargo would have been shut out, had this ammunition been accepted.

However, when the ship reached Palermo, she is stated to have loaded only 650 tons thus wasting about 700 tons of valuable shipping space.

It is requested that the matter be investigated and a full explanation forwarded without delay to this Division. It has been suggested by the shipping authorities that the balance of the civil cargo was not available at port of embarkation.

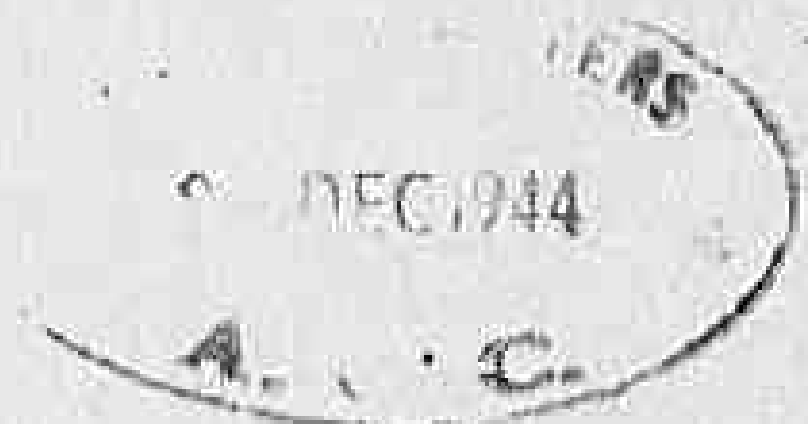

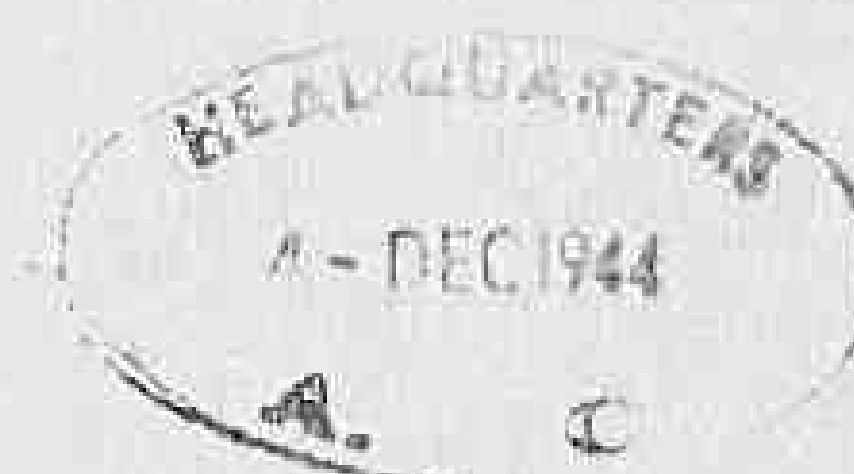

1. The SAMCEBU has been loaded with approximately 650 tons of dehydrated soup for Balkan stockpile Alexandria.
2. The SAMCEBU left Palermo 29 November.
3. The soup came from two of our warehouses but had previously been warehoused in the open when space was at a premium. Because of this, some of the cartons were damp and, in the handling, were broken open, making it necessary to sack the cans and packages at shipside before loading.
4. Despite the necessity of this sacking, no time was lost because of it. Time was lost however, through irregularity of the transportation supplied by the U.S. Navy and by the heavy rains which occurred during two days of the loading.

1. Your attention is drawn to letter this Headquarters ref P-17 of 26 November subject Cereal Ships - Notification of Arrival. The unsatisfactory and conflicting advices which you have received of the cargoes of the BOSKOOP and MENENDEZ are but further examples of the difficulties met with at AFHQ in attempting to obtain reliable information from the source of shipment. Not only does wheat suddenly become flour but in two cases it has turned into coal. The weekly Cereal Arrival Reports under reference C-36 are sufficient evidence of the confused state of notifications as received here.

2. At present there is no remedy. A strong joint cable has been sent to the various military and commercial shipping authorities as a result of the letter referred to in para 1. It is to be hoped that this will eventually have the desired result.

3. Meanwhile, AFHQ is only able to pass on to you such advices as are received. To withhold these advices would leave HQ AC without information of any sort.

4. It is hoped that you are now clear as to where the responsibility lies for these faulty advices. G-5 is more than anxious to keep you fully posted with accurate and up to date information when ever this is obtainable.

Specific instance desired in SPTOM 683, TX 70264, 29 November, was the ROBERT T HILL, which created apprehension as to future cases.

In this case civil relief cargo could only be accepted at DUKO whereas military cargo was wanted AIOL, and because of broken stowage necessitating complete discharge of vessel, it would have been 30 days or longer before civil cargo could have been transhipped back to DUKO, where it could only be accepted.

In the meantime, this civil cargo was most urgently needed. Delay in shipping has not yet occurred, but it is expected delay will be encountered delivering civil supplies, particularly if not block stowed.

1. Continual calls are being made on Mediterranean Shipping Authorities to release shipping at present allocated to this theatre for use in other theatres. Addressees will realise that in order to assess the shipping requirements in the theatre it is necessary for the authorities concerned to have a reasonably long-term programme of probable shipping requirements.

2. It will be of great assistance to the shipping authorities if the addressees of this letter can give an estimated forward programme to cover the balance of 1945 for which programmes have not yet been prepared and submitted to the Transportation Sub-Commission. Demands for port allocation, based on estimated requirements, have been submitted to AFHQ up to, and including, August, 1945. These will act as a sufficient guide to the shipping authorities for the immediate future. In the meantime will addressees please submit their anticipated future requirements to cover the period September to December, 1945, inclusive, in accordance with the attached pro forma, returns being submitted on a monthly basis.

3. Bids should be submitted on the basis that all the north has been liberated, and that the majority of ports in the north will be able to accept civilian cargoes. Industry Sub-Commission is requested to include an estimate for Sardinian coal in its programme. The programmes should cover all intra Mediterranean movement, that is not only movement from such areas as Sicily and Sardinia to the Mainland, and vice versa, but such movements as phosphate rock from North Africa to Italy, and anticipated imports and exports from and to other Mediterranean areas.
