1. There has been grave concern here over coal shipment situation as 6 out of 42 cargoes originally scheduled for September loadings failed to move due to lack of coal. Out of 48 scheduled for October loadings we have info to date that only 2 have sailed due to coal shortage as result of strike.

2. However strike settled October 17th and miners returned to work October 22nd. Solid fuels administration stated it cannot expect any pickup in shipments until November 1st since will take approx 2 weeks after miner return to work to realize any appreciable increase in production. They have made assurances, however, that coal shipments will be resumed as soon as possible and continued at maximum rate possible. Your second para MOC 335 answered COM cable 248.

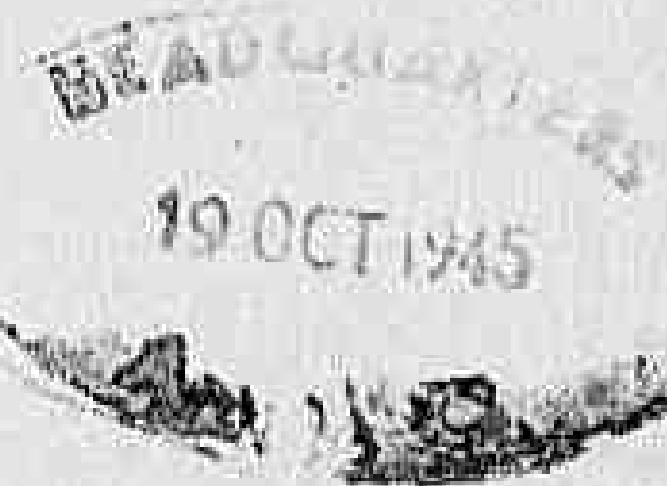
