1. We are expecting, in the near future, the repatriation of the following categories of Italians from the Dodecanese :-

- (a) 725 Italian Government ex-officials and employees with their families.
- (b) 67 unabsorbable Italians,
- (c) 137 politically undesirable Italians.

2. The Italian Government requests that the port of disembarkation in Italy be Bari, and that the Italian Government be notified, as far in advance as possible, of the expected time (and port) of arrival.

3. We shall be grateful if you will comply with their request by notifying us when we will pass on the information immediately.
