The United Maritime Authority, Zone III has handed to us a reply a letter they received from the Director General of the Mercantile Marine under date of the 19th December regarding the employment of the Motor Schooner "EROS" 320 tons D.W. operated by CO.CE.NA for a voyage to Alexandria and return to the Mainland of Italy.

It is not necessary however the request to the U.M.A. for sea transportation in view that the M.S. "EROS" is at your disposition, and consequently the U.M.A. cannot enter in respect to authority for her sailing to Alexandria and return to Italy.

As regards the export and import it is necessary the authority of I.C.E. and the voyage formalities is a domestic question between the Direction General Mercantile Marine and CO.CE.NA.

On application to the U.M.A. for freight basis with indication of the cargo to be carried, the measurement cubic, in view that Cotton in Bales is indicated, they will give the necessary figures.

1. The attached bid for balanced export and import of subject goods, as passed to us by A.C.H.Q., Rome is forwarded to you for action.

2. It has been suggested by I.C.E., consignees of the imported goods for the It. Ministry of Industry, to use for this shipment the Italian schooner "EROS" 320 Tons DW, speed 10 knots, now operated by "Cogena".

3. Such suggestion is agreed to by A.C.H.Q. and this Ministry. Upon request "Cogena" will make the above schooner available for the trip.

4. Your concurrence for the use of the "EROS" and necessary authority to have her sailed to Alexandria is therefore requested.

5. For your information, the exporting firm has submitted a statement to the effect that all port charges and expenses (including fuel) to be met by the schooner while in Egypt, will be taken care for by them in the requested foreign currency which will be made available to them by the Egyptian importer of the Italian goods.
