SUBJECT : Swiss Donation of food for City of Genoa

TO : Zone 3 Committee UMA, Naples

1. The following extract of letter dated 26 Sept received from Ente Nazionale Distribuzione Soccorsi in Rome is passed to you for information and the appropriate action as regards the outstanding 250 tons of food which requires shipment.

" The relief goods donated by "Don Suisse" (Swiss Gift) to Genoa have been reduced to

Wheat	2,000 tons
Fish, canned	185 tons

The S/s "Pertusole", which arrived in Genoa from Lisbon on Saturday Sept. 22th started unloading on Monday 24th.

The cargo shipped amounts to 1,900 tons of wheat and 35 tons of canned fish.

In such circumstances a further voyage of the S/s "Pertusole" has become unnecessary.

We would appreciate if you would consider the possibility of loading the remaining 100 tons of wheat and 150 tons of canned fish on some other S/s touching at Lisbon on her way to Genoa."

1. Enclosed is copy of letter from ENDSI dated 26 Sept. indicating that the gift of the Swiss Government to City of Genoa has been reduced and that most of the tonnage has already been lifted on the S/S Pertusola.

2. You will note that a small balance of 100 tons wheat and 150 tons fish remains at Lisbon and ENDSI requests that you arrange to load it on some ship touching at Lisbon bound for Genoa. The cargo can, of course, be railed to Genoa from some other Italian Port if a ship is found touching at Lisbon and destined for any Italian port.

3. We will appreciate it if you will do what you can to find a ship to pick up the small balance left at Lisbon. The Italian Legation at Lisbon gave the instructions for loading the Pertusola and so will be in a position to give instructions for the balance remaining.
